Dear TOGETHER We Pray Team,

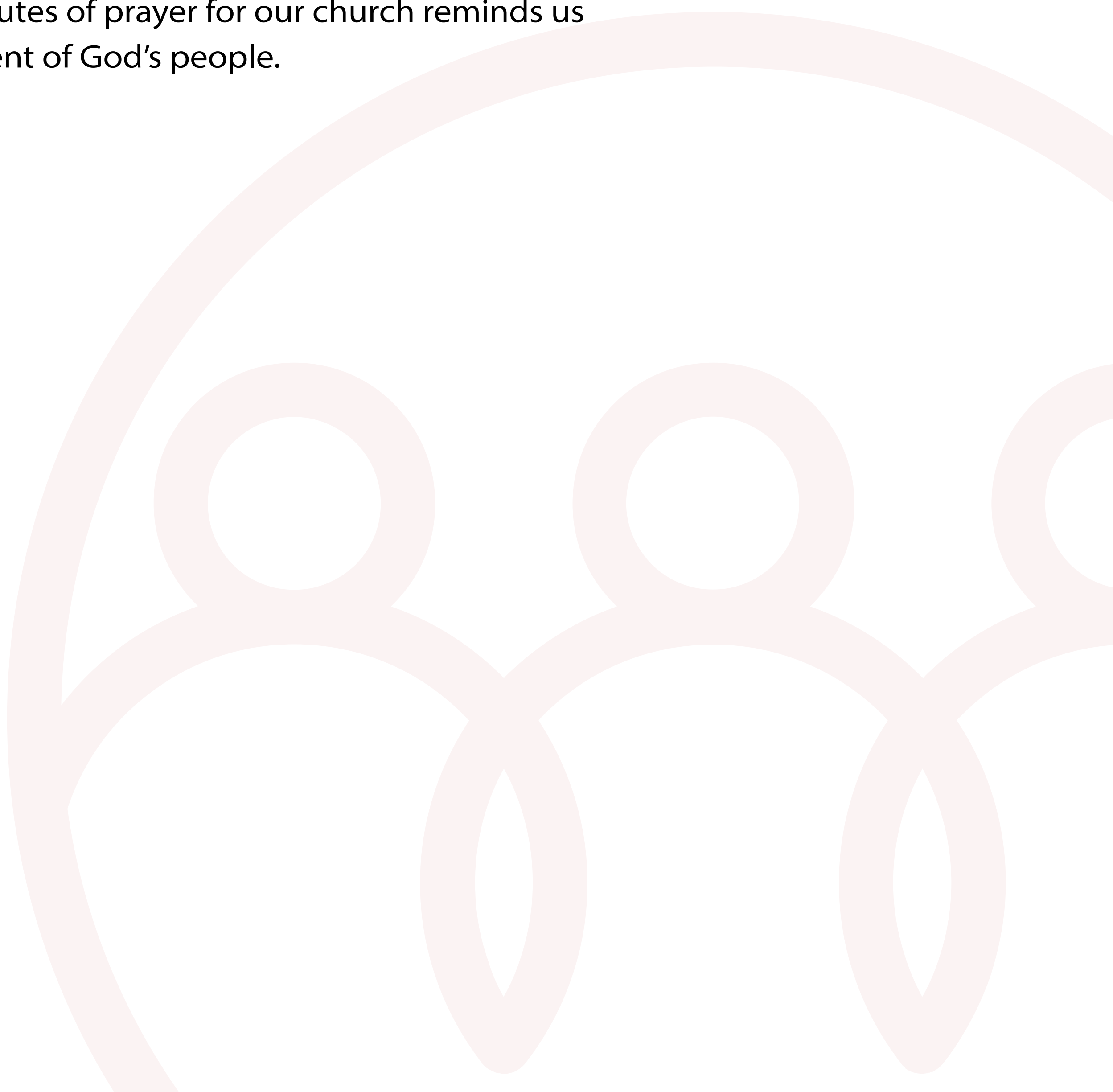

April 2026 PRAYER POINTS

PREPARING YOURSELF TO PRAY (6 Minutes)

Walking In The Light

"If we walk in the light as he himself is in the light, we have fellowship with one another; and the blood of Jesus his Son cleanses us from all sin." 1 John 1:7

- Declare to God: I will walk in the light!
- Declare to God: I want to have fellowship with You!
- Appeal to God: Father, may the blood of Jesus cleanse me from all my sins right now! I receive your total forgiveness. Thank you.

Walking In Thanksgiving For Answered Prayer

"I will give thanks to you because you have answered me." Psalm 118:21

- Thank you, Lord, for beginning to work mightily in our church.
- Thank you, Lord, for saving lost people, including many adults, and seeing them baptized to God's glory.
- Thank you, Lord, for our church beginning to come together in unity.

PRAYER POINTS AND GUIDE FOR APRIL (20 Minutes)

Prayer Point 1: Lord, please bring people from the North, South, East, and West to our church so they can be saved, baptized, and/or committed to our vision of being like Jesus' Church in Acts 1:8.

*"They will come from east and west, from north and south, to share the banquet in the kingdom of God."
Luke 13:29*

- Jesus, Your promise concerns people from all regions entering Your Kingdom and walking Your narrow way to follow You. So Jesus, bring people to Grand Church to be saved, baptized, and to live Your vision for Your church here.
- Jesus, draw people to our church here, week by week, and for special experiences like Easter Sunday, April 5, and Women's Night, April 12.

Prayer Point 2: Father, we ask You for a life-changing and dynamic Easter Sunday on April 5, during our 10:30 AM Worship Service.

"He is not here. For he has risen, just as he said, Come and see the place where he lay. Then, go quickly and tell his disciples." Matthew 28:6-7

- God, we ask You to move on our people between now and Easter Sunday, to invite and bring others to be here on Easter Sunday Morning Worship.
- Lord, fill Your House, Your Church here, until it is full and overflowing with people this Easter.
- Holy Spirit, fill Your House and Your Church with the manifested presence of God like we've never experienced before on Easter.
- Jesus, may Your resurrection power among us transform many lives this Easter through salvation, the testimony of baptism, and the powerful dynamic presence of God in our midst.

Prayer Point 3: Great God of Heaven, Lord of Hosts, bring hundreds of women from all over this region to WOMEN'S NIGHT and AFTER PARTY, April 12 at 5:30 PM.

"Look, I am about to do something new; even now it is coming. Do you not see it? Indeed, I will make a way in the wilderness, rivers in the desert." Isaiah 43:19

- Oh God, on this special night, do a new thing in the lives of all women who attend and bring about a new thing that will impact our entire church.
- Holy Spirit, draw women of all ages and generations, including singles, married women, and even young girls in middle school and high school.
- Jesus, save those who are lost, baptize those who begin to follow Jesus that night, and disciple everyone to live like Jesus in a greater way.
- Anoint the entire evening with the Holy Spirit, especially anoint those leading the event: Jeana Floyd, who will lead the evening and a panel of women; Meredith Floyd, our main speaker for the evening; and Christen Kordsmeier and Amber Roberts, who will lead worship with other Cross Church Singers and Band.

Prayer Point 4: Holy Spirit, anoint and use our Interim Pastor, Dr. Ronnie Floyd, as he provides preaching, leadership, and wisdom for our church, our church leaders, and our staff team.

"So Elisha answered, 'Please, let me inherit two shares (double portion) of your spirit.'" 2 Kings 2:9

- Holy Spirit, anoint Pastor Ronnie with a double portion of Your Spirit as he prepares, preaches, leads, and guides us.
- Holy Spirit, anoint our church leaders and ministry staff team with a double portion of Your Spirit.
- Pray now for our Ministry Staff Team members and spouses: Pastor Ronnie Floyd (Wife Jeana), Will Guyton (Wife Camille), Chad Mann (Wife Amy), Jonah Morrow (Wife Katie), AJ Popa (Wife Callie), Kendall Price (Wife Kathy)

Prayer Point 5: Lord Jesus Christ, as we begin to pray for the process and election of our Pastor Search Committee, we ask You to unify Your church, purify our hearts, and clarify who You want to entrust this significant spiritual assignment.

“Now if any of you lacks wisdom, he should ask God--who gives to all generously and ungrudgingly--and it will be given to you.” James 1:5

- Lord, we ask You for wisdom for our church to know who You want to entrust this significant spiritual assignment.
- Lord, may these people be filled with the Holy Spirit and overflowing with the fruit of the Spirit in their lives: love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, and self-control. (Ephesians 5:18 & Galatians 5:22-23)
- Lord, we seek who You want to do this and refuse any process or person with impure motives, or anyone with a personal agenda. (1 Corinthians 3:1-4)
- Lord, You are getting Your Pastor ready to serve here; so please raise up the people here You want to place on this Pastor Search Committee so they can go and identify for us who God is calling here as the next Pastor for Grand Avenue Baptist Church. Then, oh Lord, may the church here confirm whom God is calling here.

Pray now 1 Corinthians 1:10 - “Now I urge you, brothers and sisters, in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ, that all of you agree in what you say, that there be no divisions among you, and that you be united with the same understanding and conviction.”

CONCLUDING TIME (4 Minutes)

- Review each request individually and pray one more time for God’s supernatural and miraculous touch to be on it.
- BEGIN each Saturday, when you see the sun begin to go down: Pause 1 minute and pray for Sunday and for God to meet with all of us powerfully and supernaturally.
