## March 2026 PRAYER POINTS


**Dear TOGETHER We Pray Team,**

# March 2026 PRAYER POINTS

## PREPARING YOURSELF TO PRAY (8 Minutes)

### Thanksgiving

- Spend one minute thanking God for one thing He is doing in our church right now.

### Confession

*"He erased the certificate of debt, with its obligations, that was against us and opposed to us and has taken it away by nailing it to the cross." Colossians 2:14*

- Confess your sins and turn from them.
- Claim what Jesus did for you by His death on the Cross.
- Rejoice that Jesus erased all your sins and nailed them to the Cross.

### Petition

*"But you, dear friends, as you build yourselves up in your most holy faith, praying in the Holy Spirit." Jude 1:20*

- Ask the Holy Spirit to fill you, anoint you, and lead you as you pray.
- Lord, build my faith as I pray today.
- Holy Spirit, may I pray as you lead, guide, and empower my praying.

## PRAYER POINTS AND GUIDE FOR MARCH (20 Minutes)

**Prayer Point 1: God, we believe You are doing something new in our lives and church family. May this spiritual breakthrough happen in ways greater than we have ever seen or imagined.**

*"Do not remember the past events; pay no attention to things of old. Look, I am about to do something new; even now it is coming. Do you not see it? Indeed, I will make a way in the wilderness, and rivers in the desert."  
Isaiah 43:18-19*

- Lord, help us not to live in the past, but to see that God is doing something new.
- Holy Spirit, come upon us and fall on us, doing something new in me and in our church. Help everyone to see You are doing something new!
- God, make a way in the wilderness and rivers in the desert.
- Spirit of God, place a double anointing upon Dr. Ronnie Floyd as he preaches and leads our staff team and church in this transitional season.

**Prayer Point 2: Holy Spirit, empower us to be all about this missional vision: *Reaching Metro Fort Smith, Arkansas, America, and the World for Jesus Christ.***

*"But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit has come on you, and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem, in all Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth." Acts 1:8*

- Holy Spirit, we receive Your power to accomplish Your missional vision.
- God, empower me and others in our church to become Your witnesses.
- Father, use us to take the Good News of Jesus Christ to all 180,000 people in Metro Fort Smith.
- Lord, draw people from Fort Smith, Van Buren, Greenwood, Alma, Barling, and Mulberry, as well as other nearby communities, to come here to Grand Church and be transformed by the power of Jesus Christ.

**Prayer Point 3: Lord, we ask You to draw hundreds of men to our MEN'S NIGHT on SUNDAY, MARCH 15 and to move in their lives powerfully.**

*"For the training of the body has limited benefit, but godliness is beneficial in every way, since it holds promise for the present life and also for the life to come." 1 Timothy 4:8*

- Father, we ask You to anoint our speakers for this night with the power of the Holy Spirit: Dr. Grant Etheridge, Dr. Nick Floyd, and Dr. Ronnie Floyd, as he leads and shepherds this evening.
- Holy Spirit, also anoint our worship with power, as the Cross Church Singers and Band provide worship support under the leadership of Dr. Julio Arriola.
- Lord, please draw hundreds of men to our Men's Night, and pray that many will come to Jesus Christ and that all our men will be moved to be all God wants them to be.

**Prayer Point 4: God, HARVEST SUNDAY MORNING will occur on SUNDAY, MARCH 15; Move our people to invite lost men, women, students, and children to Sunday Morning Worship at 10:30 AM and may they begin to follow Jesus that day.**

*"The Lord does not delay his promise, as some understand delay, but is patient with you, not wanting any to perish but all to come to repentance." 2 Peter 3:9*

- Lord, we know You want all people to repent and be saved; therefore, please save many who are lost without Jesus on SUNDAY MORNING, MARCH 15. Move our people to invite people who need Jesus and others who need a new church home.
- Holy Spirit, anoint Dr. Grant Etheridge as he preaches on SUNDAY MORNING, MARCH 15, serving in this capacity alongside our Interim Pastor, Dr. Ronnie Floyd, on that day.
- Jesus, save the lost, and convict the saved to be baptized, and may we teach all of Jesus' followers how to live like Jesus.

**Prayer Point 5: Lord Jesus, may you draw hundreds of women from all over this region to come to our WOMEN'S NIGHT and AFTER PARTY on SUNDAY, APRIL 12 from 5:00-8:30 PM.**

*"For we are God's masterpiece. He has created us anew in Christ Jesus, so we can do the good things he planned for us long ago." Ephesians 2:10*

- Lord God, anoint with the power of the Holy Spirit: Jeana Floyd, who will provide leadership this evening; Meredith Floyd, who will be our main speaker this evening; a panel of women who will encourage all; and our Cross Church Singers and Band, under the leadership of Christen Kordsmeier and Amber Roberts. Use each to Your glory!
- Holy Spirit, come in great power, speak to all who attend, and do great things in their lives. Encourage the saved. Save those who are lost. Lead each to follow Jesus and live for him from salvation to baptism to learning to live like Jesus.
- Lord, draw women from the north, the south, the east, and the west to be part of this gathering. From middle school and high school girls to women of all ages, singles and married, do a great thing for everyone on this night!

**Prayer Point 6: God, we ask you to do a mighty work in our EASTER SUNDAY MORNING WORSHIP SERVICE on APRIL 5 at 10:30 AM.**

*"Don't be alarmed," he told them. "You are looking for Jesus of Nazareth, who was crucified. He has risen! He is not here. See the place where they put him. But go, tell!" Mark 16:6*

- Lord Jesus, may Your resurrection power inspire people to come to our church on Easter Sunday morning and fill Your house to overflowing.
- Anoint and inspire our Interim Pastor, Dr. Ronnie Floyd, with the resurrection power of Jesus as he preaches and calls people to follow Jesus as Lord.
- God, use our greeters, our ushers, our choir and orchestra, our staff team, and our people to create a culture that God will anoint powerfully, so people will come back to Grand weekly.
- Jesus Christ, we believe You died for the sins of the world. On Easter morning, call many lost children, lost students, and lost adults, from college age to senior age, to come to know You personally, be baptized, and follow You daily.
