As Lutheran Christians, we believe that this sacrament is more than just a memorial meal. We believe in Christ's real presence in, under, and through the bread and the wine for the forgiveness of sins. If you are a baptized Christian, and this is what you believe and desire, we invite you to join us in this most sacred meal! If this is not your confession, or you are not sure what you believe about the Lord's Supper, we are thankful that you are worshiping with us but ask that you please refrain from taking communion today. Our pastoral staff would be happy to follow up with you about participating in Holy Communion in the future.

## CONFESSION AND ABSOLUTION

P: Beloved in the Lord, today we remember the Unsung Saint Phinehas, who was driven by zeal for the Lord's Law. While we strive for following the Lord with all our heart, our soul, all our strength, and all our mind, we recognize that we have not done so. We confess that we often seek glory for ourselves rather than humble service in His kingdom. Our zeal is not for God, but rather self-centered and wayward. Let us therefore bow in confession, asking God's grace and forgiveness for the sake of Christ Jesus. *(please kneel)*

P: Gracious Heavenly Father,

C: **We confess that we have sinned against You in thought, word, and deed: by failing to trust Your promises, by fearing the world more than You, by neglecting our neighbor, and by doubting that Your will for our lives is always good. Like Unsung Saints of old, we too grow weary. We tremble before overwhelming troubles. We resist Your calling. We falter in fear and indifference. For the sake of Jesus Christ, forgive us, renew us, and lead us, that we may delight in Your will and walk in Your ways to the glory of Your holy name. Amen.**  
*(silence for personal confession)*

P: Almighty God in His mercy has given His Son to die for you and for His sake forgives you all your sins. Christ Jesus came not for the mighty, but for sinners; not for the righteous, but for the broken; not for the self-sufficient, but for those who hunger and thirst for righteousness.

Upon this your confession, I, by virtue of my office as a called and ordained servant of the Word, announce the grace of God unto all of you, and in the stead and by the command of my Lord Jesus Christ, I forgive you all your sins in the name of the Father and of the (†) Son and of the Holy Spirit.
