## NICENE CREED

P: Rejoicing in the goodness our Triune God, we boldly proclaim our faith:

### For the Suffering

- L: *(Mary Magdalene): I stood outside the tomb weeping. I thought everything was lost. Then He spoke my name, "Mary."*
- P: Lord Jesus, You who called Mary from her grief into joy, draw near to all who are suffering today. Speak Your life-giving Word to the sick, the lonely, the anxious, and the grieving.
- C: **Risen Lord, call us by name and restore our hope.**

### For the Church's Life:

- L: *(Saints today): We gather in churches and homes across the world. We sing ancient hymns and new songs of praise. We come as people baptized into Christ's death and resurrection.*
- P: Living Savior, lead Your people to live as Easter people. Fill us with faith, courage, generosity, and love, that our lives may bear witness to Your victory over sin and death.
- C: **Risen Lord, raise us to new life.**

### For the Resurrection Hope:

- L: *(Disciples): We gathered behind locked doors, fearful and uncertain. The cross had shattered our hopes, and the tomb seemed to seal our future. But the risen Lord stood among us and spoke peace.*
- P: Lord Jesus Christ, conqueror of death, strengthen all who live in the shadow of the grave. Remind us that because You live, those who belong to You shall live also. Keep us steadfast in the promise that the day is coming when every tomb will be opened and every tear wiped away.
- C: **Risen Lord, raise us to everlasting life.**
- P: Into Your hands, O victorious Lord, we commend all for whom we pray, trusting in Your mercy and rejoicing in Your resurrection; for You live and reign with the Father and the Holy Spirit, one God, now and forever.
