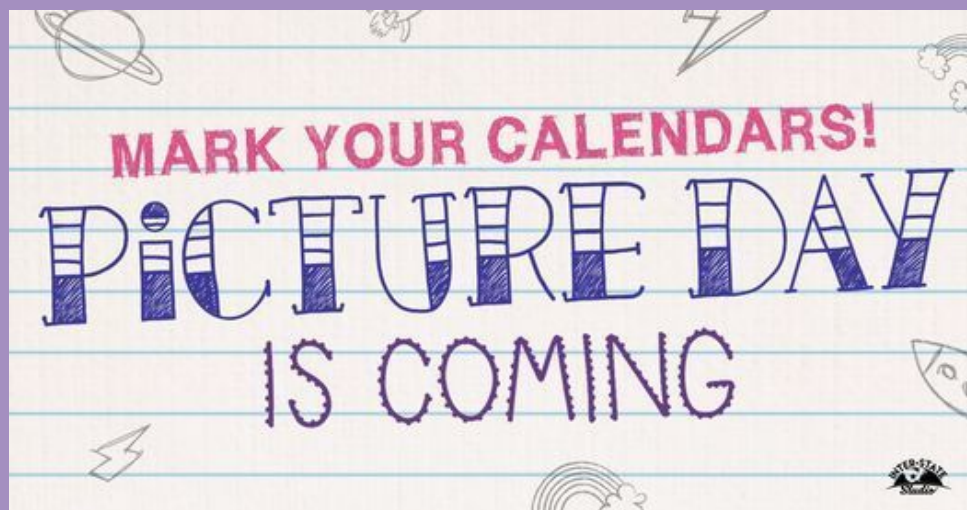

These opportunities are organized by each teacher per the needs of their individual classroom. ***Should you wish to volunteer, please reach out directly to your child's teacher to discuss what that might look like.*** We all have our specific talents and it's Biblical! "*As each has received a gift, use it to serve one another, as good stewards of God's varied grace.*" (1 Peter 4:10).

Additionally, because our children's safety is the highest priority, all classroom and campus visitors MUST:

1. Check in at the office to fill out the Visitors Log with our receptionist, Jacky Valencia.
2. ALL VISITORS MUST HAVE AN APPOINTMENT, SET IN ADVANCE, TO VISIT/VOLUNTEER IN THEIR CHILD'S CLASSROOM OR THE PLAYGROUND.
Instructional time is an important priority, therefore it's critical that parents have an appointment before volunteering or visiting. This minimizes classtime interruptions. These appointments are made directly with your child's teacher. Our receptionist will double check that individuals are expected before signing visitors in.
3. Receive a Visitors Badge and place it prominently on your person so it's easily seen. If a Visitors Badge is not present or easily visible, individuals will be asked to return to the office to check in.
4. All visitors will need to check out when they leave, as well.

We are so blessed by God's abundant goodness to allow us to, once again, bring our parents closer alongside us here at school! Many thanks!

BEGINNING SPANISH - SERIES I



The key element in teaching a foreign language is to keep students motivated! The course style and technique brings interaction, enthusiasm, cultural elements, and technology into the classroom to keep children excited and interested. My objective as your child's Spanish teacher is to foster a level of independence during their elementary school years, where they develop a desire to learn and think for themselves. In this course, we will build vocabulary and learn conversational Spanish. Some topics include greetings, counting, helpful words, colors, family members, foods, days, months, some verb tenses, and more. Teaching my native Spanish language enables me to draw upon my own culture and personal experience as a foreign language learner at the young age of 5, as I teach my students to effectively communicate with me in Spanish and, perhaps more importantly, to gain an appreciation for another language and culture. This course continues during the Spring semester should you want to register again at that time.

BEGINNING SPANISH - SERIES 2




Beginning Spanish - Series 2 is the perfect class for students who have taken my Beginning Spanish - Series 1 Course for a full year or who speak in simple sentences on various topics, and are at a level to begin reading the language. The course continues where we let off and will assist students in expanding the vocabulary/topics we learned. It includes who, what, where, when questions, more counting, new verbs, clothing, time, dates, places to go, rooms in a house, and more. We develop transitional level speaking, listening, reading, and writing skills while exposing students to Spanish-speaking cultures. Oral communication activities at this level are designed to promote communicative ability and self-expression. This course continues during the Spring semester should you want to register again at that time.

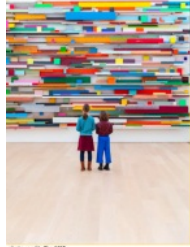

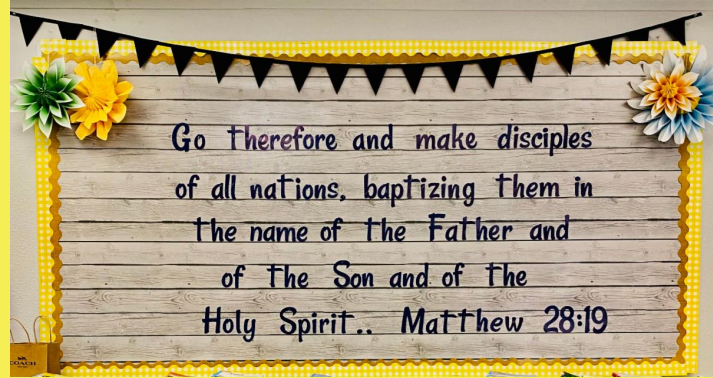
