Choose one side of your cube for each theme: Your Name, Morning Star, God, Jesus, Spirit, and the Church. Using any drawing implements, draw a simple image, symbol, word, color, or pattern that represents each one to you. There are no wrong answers. You might use traditional faith symbols, images from nature, abstract designs, or pictures that remind you of love, welcome, service, peace, movement, or community. This is not about making perfect art, but about expressing faith, identity, and connection as we continue this spiritual journey together. Here are some ideas.

Spirit	Dove, flame	Wind, flowing water, clouds	Swirls, waves, breath lines	Dancing, music, uplifted hands
Church (universal)	Globe, many crosses, many people	Forest, garden, river system	Quilt squares, connected circles	Diverse hands together, table fellowship, community care
