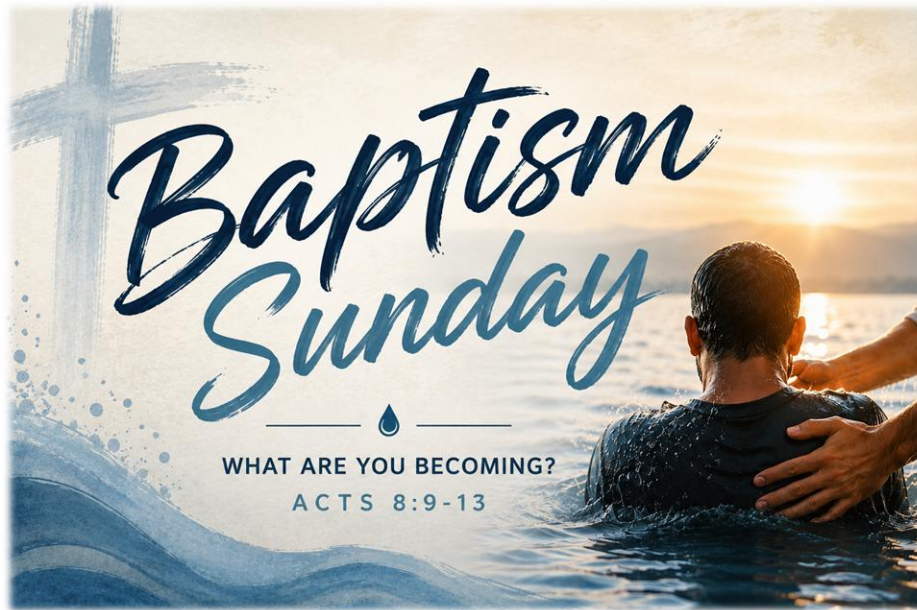




What Are You Becoming?

Acts 8: 9 - 13

I'd like you to consider this: Every one of us is becoming someone. Whether we realize it or not, our lives are being shaped every day.

So, the question is not, "Am I becoming something?" The question is, "What am I becoming?"

Our world has its own vision of what we should become.

But what is God's vision? What kind of people is God trying to create?

Sometimes people ask, 'What is God trying to do in my life?' The answer is both simple and life changing. God is making you more like Jesus.

God's purpose is making a people who look like Jesus. But how does He do that? The Bible answers this in one remarkable verse:

^{13a} Even Simon himself believed, and after being baptized he continued with Philip.

We believe in Jesus.

We are baptized into Jesus.

We become like Jesus.

We began with the question, "What are you becoming?" That's still the question. Every one of us is becoming someone, and God's purpose is to make us more like Jesus. If you've never believed, trust Him today. If you've believed but have never been baptized, take that next step. And remember: God is still at work making you more like Jesus. Every one of us is becoming someone. By God's grace, may we become a people who look more like Jesus.
