The King's Road: The Sending of Disciples (Matthew 10:16–28)

Small Group Discussion Questions

Sheep on the King's Road

Jesus describes disciples as *sheep among wolves*. What does that image reveal about the nature of following Jesus in the world? Where do you most feel that tension today?

Wisdom without Compromise

Jesus calls His disciples to be *wise as serpents and innocent as doves*. What does faithful discernment look like in your life right now without slipping into fear, deception, or compromise?

Betrayal and Allegiance

Jesus warns that allegiance to Him may even divide families. How have you experienced tension, misunderstanding, or loss because of your commitment to Christ?

Fear Reordered

According to Jesus, what fears are misplaced—and what fear is right and necessary? How does fearing God reshape how we face people, pressure, or persecution?

Speaking When It's Costly

Jesus promises that the Spirit will speak through His disciples when they are pressured or opposed. Where might God be calling you to speak—or act—boldly instead of staying silent?

Endurance on the King's Road

Jesus says, "The one who endures to the end will be saved." What helps sustain endurance in your walk with Christ when the road feels hard or lonely?

Application

Where is Jesus currently sending you to live out your faith—even if it feels uncomfortable or costly—and what would faithfulness look like there this week?

What fear of people or outcomes has been shaping your obedience, and what would change if your fear of the King outweighed every other fear?

Prayer Prompts (Group or Quiet Prayer)

Courage and Clarity

Lord, reorder our fears. Help us to fear You above all else and to trust You when following Jesus feels risky or costly.

Faithful Endurance

Father, strengthen us to endure on the King's Road. When opposition, rejection, or fear rises, anchor us in Your truth and sustain us by Your Spirit.
