The King's Road: Value, Expectation, and Reward

Matthew 10:29–42

Discussion Questions

I. How God Values Jesus' Disciples

(Matthew 10:29–31)

Jesus uses sparrows and the numbering of our hair to illustrate God's care. How do these images help you understand the depth of God's attention to your life?

When fear or pressure rises, how does remembering your value to God change the way you respond?

II. What Jesus Expects from His Disciples

(Matthew 10:32–39)

Jesus calls His followers to acknowledge Him publicly. What are some situations today where acknowledging Christ may feel difficult or costly?

Jesus says our allegiance to Him must be greater than even our closest relationships. What does that kind of priority look like in everyday life?

III. How God Rewards Those Who Receive Jesus' Disciples

(Matthew 10:40–42)

Jesus teaches that receiving His disciples is the same as receiving Him. What are practical ways believers today can support and participate in God's mission?

Jesus says even a small act—like giving a cup of cold water—will not go unnoticed. How does this reshape the way you think about seemingly small acts of service?

Application Questions

Where might Jesus be asking you to acknowledge Him more openly in your daily life this week?

When pressure or conflict comes, what would it look like for you to show that your allegiance to Christ comes before comfort, reputation, or approval?

Prayer Prompts

Thank God for His care and attention.

Praise Him that your life is known and valued by Him—even in the smallest details.

Ask for courage to acknowledge Christ.

Pray for boldness to live openly as a follower of Jesus, even when it is uncomfortable.

Pray for loyalty in your heart.

Ask God to help you love Christ above every other relationship or priority.

Pray for a servant's heart.

Ask the Lord to help you notice opportunities to support and encourage those who are serving Him.
