

The Best Advice I Ever Got from Rock Music

In 1980 one of the most successful rock bands in history broke up. The Eagles have had five number one singles, six number one albums, six Grammy awards and have sold more than 200 million records. Their greatest hits album is still the bestselling album in American history. Yet they could not overcome pride, personality and money. After 14 years of being broken up they finally got back together in 1994. Their first new song was titled, "Get Over It". That is the advice they needed for themselves and the advice that many of us need today.

Do not seek revenge or bear a grudge against anyone among your people, but love your neighbor as yourself. I am the LORD. Leviticus 19:18

Holding a grudge against someone is like drinking poison every day. The grudge will occupy space in your mind, control your emotions and even effect your health in a negative way. By holding a grudge you are giving someone power over you that they don't deserve. Even if their offence is "grudge worthy", God tells us that we need to get over it. That is easier said than done. But here is the secret. You have to turn it over to God and let God take care of it in His way and in His time. I love the final phrase of Leviticus 19:18, "I am the Lord." God is reminding us that He is the Lord, not us. To hold a grudge is to set ourselves up as judge and jury. It is not our place to decide if someone else is worthy of forgiveness.

Forgiving is not condoning. Forgiving others frees you from the burden of bondage. Not only will you be free, forgiving others is a way of displaying your faith in God. Faith is believing that God knows even more than you do about what happened and trusting that God can resolve the situation much better than you ever could on your own. If that still seems overwhelming, let Paul remind each of us why we should forgive others.

Get rid of all bitterness, rage and anger, brawling and slander, along with every form of malice. Be kind and compassionate to one another, forgiving each other, just as in Christ God forgave you. Ephesians 4:31-32

The sooner we can "get over it" the sooner we can get on with living.
