“Wandering all throughout the wilderness.”

“Oh, nothing.”

Other nations were not that worried about the Israelites. They were just a ragtag bunch of former slaves with no sense of direction, no military skills and no weapons. And besides, how could a group that size sustain life wandering through the wilderness for that long? The truth is, they couldn’t. Unless they had an amazing God! God did countless miracles on a daily basis to get this group from Egypt to the Promise Land. One of the most amazing miracles that God did every morning was to provide manna for the entire nation.

As the sun rose every morning there was enough food spread on the ground for the whole group to eat. The only exception was Saturday morning. There was no food on Saturday morning, but on Friday morning there was a double portion so everyone was covered. You would think that after a few weeks, months or years the people would develop trust in the God that provided for them every day. But... people will be people.
