Pastor Jeff is requesting a collection of used items to be shipped to Sierra Leone, West Africa. The items will be placed on a shipping container in Elizabethtown, to be sent in August.

Items needed: Tools such as hammers, screw drivers, bars, wrenches, saws, squares, cement tools, levels, utility knives, rakes, shovels, picks. Also, hardware items stored around the home: nails, bolts, screws, hinges, etc. Tupperware or other such containers, eating utensils, pans, sheets, blankets, towels, and washcloths. Clothing and shoes for all ages, items for children are especially needed.

You may pack and or collect suitcases no longer needed for shipping or consider purchasing containers listed below since cardboard boxes break down. Your donations are gladly accepted with or without a suitcase or container. I have purchased over a dozen large black plastic boxes with yellow lids for storage. If able, feel free to purchase such a container which makes our shipping easier for stacking reasons. I will care for any additional needed containers. For those who desire, the containers may be purchased at Lowes. 17 Gallon/68 quart = \$10.98 or

40 Gallon/160 quart = \$24.98

McVeytown Presbyterian Session has approved a week of service with the Navajo Ministry in Shiprock, New Mexico. Through your gifts, Session has approved \$3,000 to be used toward the purchase of materials to be used on this mission. We will have two projects: Jim & Bessie suffered major damage from a storm. Their roof has been repaired; we will complete this project by painting the interior of the home which suffered water damage. Jim is a 92-year old Korean War Veteran who was wounded twice during the war. The other home required replacement of a wheelchair deck, outside wood trim, and painting the exterior of the home. Your generosity will be a great blessing and sign of hope for both families.

Previous mission housing with separate rooms for men and women was lost during Covid. For this reason, we are limited to a smaller team of 6-10 men with the hopes of finding better lodging for a mix team next year. The cost of the week including airfare, lodging, food, car rentals/fuel, and other living expenses is \$1,750. If you are interested, please contact Pastor Jeff as soon as possible. (717-350-6427.
