How to Use Libby

OverDrive's Libby app is a reading app that also allows you to enjoy digital titles. Libby works with any Android, iOS, or Windows 10 device.

- Install the Libby app from the app store on your Android, iOS, or Windows 10 device.
- In Libby, follow the prompts to find your library and sign in with a valid library card.
- Browse our library's collection and borrow a title.
- Borrowed titles appear on your Shelf and download to the app automatically when you're on Wi-Fi so you can read them when you're offline.
- From your Shelf, you can tap Open Book, or Open Audiobook to start reading or listening.
- From your Shelf, you can tap Manage Loan to see options like Renew, Return, or Send to Device to send a book to Kindle.

Tennessee R.E.A.D.S. and Libby are both the same database. Libby is the more user-friendly and app-based version, while the R.E.A.D.S. is web-based.



How to Send Books to Kindle

Start by going directly to the Tennessee R.E.A.D.S website at reads.overdrive.com or using the Libby app on your phone.

- Select our library from the drop-down list and enter your library card number
- To see only Kindle books, you can click on the Kindle Books link from the main menu.
- Click Borrow if the title is available! If the item has a wait list, you can place a hold.
- Use the drop-down menu to select your checkout period and tap Borrow.
- Next to the book, choose Read now with Kindle. You can get the Kindle book at a later time by clicking the book icon in the top right.
- Amazon will load in a new tab or window. Find Get Library Book on the right.
- If you are already signed in, confirm the device to which you want the book delivered. If you are not signed in, click Get library book and sign in to your account.
- After you choose your device, click Continue.
- Your Kindle book will be delivered the next time your device syncs.

To access our wealth of digital content, you will need a valid Jackson-Madison County Library Card.

How to Use Hoopla

Start by going directly to the Hoopla website at hoopladigital.com or downloading the hoopla app on your phone, tablet, or smart TV.

- In Hoopla, follow the prompts to find your library, sign in with a valid library card, and enter your email address and a password.
- Browse the collection and find the title you would like, then click Borrow.
- You will get a pop-up letting you know how long you can borrow the title. TV Shows, movies, music, and audiobooks all have different loan times, so please note that so you can enjoy your borrowed title!
- Find borrowed titles under "My Hoopla" to start listening or watching and enjoy!
