

The Holy Spirit – continued.

After our conversion, the primary role of the Christian is to develop a holy character and holy conduct. That is where the Holy Spirit comes to work in our lives. He takes up residence with the thought of aiding us for regeneration. Regeneration is by way of *sanctification*.

Sanctifying knowledge.

Knowledge is a must. Knowledge of the scriptures is a must for us to be sanctified, to grow in Christ as a Christian. To become holy, we must first know what holiness is. To rid ourselves of sin and remove it totally from our lives, we must know what God declares is sinful.

See: 2 Timothy 3:16-17. The Spirit can help us understand the Scripture.

Sanctifying power.

We need this power from the Holy Spirit. Someone said: *Our knowledge of what is right usually exceeds our doing what is right*. We can have informed minds, but our wills are weak at times. True of us all we must say.

Romans 8:13: says we must be *putting to death the deeds of the body*. This is not automatic. We have heard some say, ‘now that I am a Christian, I no longer sin’. Wrong. Paul says we must personally will and do this eradication of sin in our lives!

The good news is, the indwelling Spirit is the key to our victory over sin!

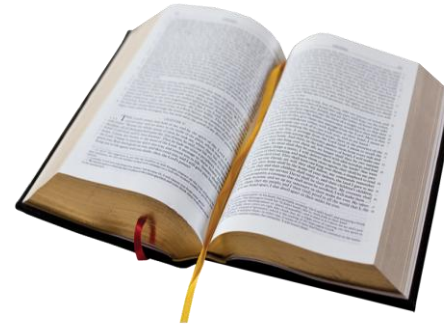
