

The Holy Spirit – continued.

We have seen in previous articles how the Holy Spirit works in our lives before we are a Christian. What does He do in the lives of the Christian today? Remember, at conversion the repentant sinner is baptized and receives the Holy Spirit as a gift. This teaches that the third person of the Trinity enters our lives in a special way and remains there, at baptism.

He gives us the *power* to morally live as we should. He gives us the power to live a holy life for the Lord.

The familiar verse of 1 Cor. 6:19, teaches this indwelling: “Or do you not know that your body is a temple of the Holy Spirit who is in you, whom you have from God, and that you are not your own.” This is the gift that we receive at baptism. God the Spirit now comes into us. (See also, Romans 8:9-11; 2 Timothy 1:14.)

Also, we must note that the Spirit dwells only within the Christian. He is selective. We have assurance because God says so. But this indwelling is not based on some personal experience, such as a glowing feeling, a warm fuzzy feeling or an episode of tongue-speaking.

Such experiences have nothing to do with conversion and the Spirit’s presence. (Matt. 7:21-23). Thus, we believe the Spirit is in us because of the promise found in the words of God. (Acts 2:38-39; Ezekiel 36:27.).

"Mary and Joseph and the baby Jesus on a flight to Egypt", he says. "And who's the fourth person?" she asked. "That's Pontius, the pilot."

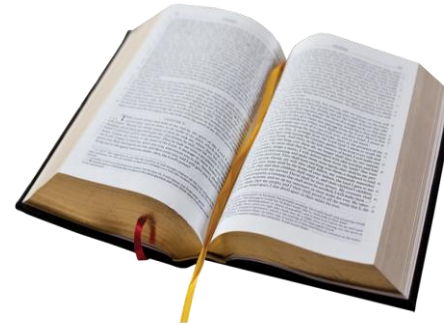
