Have your child retell the story in order.</b></p>	<p>17 <b>Parents Share:</b> What helps you continue to trust and follow God, even through difficult times?</p>	<p>18 19 20 <b>"Make a Rain Shaker"</b> Cover one end of a cardboard tube with duct tape. Squeeze together pieces of aluminum foil and place them inside the tube. Place a handful of dry rice in the cardboard tube. Cover the other end of the tube with duct tape. Turn the tube from side to side, listening to the "rain" sounds. Rain can feel dark and gloomy, but rain often leads to rainbows. Sometimes justice does not always feel good to us, but we can know that God is both just and kind, which means He always does what is right and what is loving and helpful.
