CHRISTIAN EDUCATION

Children *

Children's ministry includes Sunday School and monthly events. Teach, assist or plan events to help grow our children 3 years old-5th grade.

Youth *

Youth ministry includes Sunday School, Sunday evening meetings and monthly fellowship events. Teach, assist, or chaperone youth in 6th-12 grade.

Nursery *

Provide care for infants through age 2.

Lead an existing Sunday School class/small group or start something new!

HOSPITALITY

Sunday Morning Fellowship Time

Maintain the snack table and coffee area between Sunday morning worship services.

Fellowship Events

Organize and serve at fellowship events such as the Church picnic and Christmas caroling throughout the year.

Welcome Center

Provide information, greet guests, organize printed material.

Greeters *

Provide a warm greeting to those arriving for worship.

Funeral Coordinator

Support staff and families during funerals, helping to greet guests and fill in where needed.

Parking Lot Attendant

Direct guests to available parking for holidays and special events.

TAIZÉ WORSHIP (4TH SATURDAY, 6 PM)

Ushers *

Greet, distribute bulletins, receive offering, count worshippers Sunday mornings.

Acolyte

Light candles Sunday morning. Taizé service needs lighting candles & clean-up.

Communion Stewards & Altar Guild

Set up communion at the altar monthly, change paraments seasonally, prepare sanctuary for Sunday worship.

Liturgist

Lead Sunday morning worship liturgy.

MUSIC & ART

Chancel Choir (Adult)

Sing anthems for most 10:45 AM services, September through May. Open to all singers, high school age and older. Rehearsals are Thursday, 7:45-9:15 PM and/or Sundays 9:30-10:30 AM.

Chapel Choir (Youth)

Open to all youth choir (grades 7-12)
Rehearsals are Wednesdays, 7-8 PM

Choir (Children)

Cherub Choir (Children Age 3 - Grade 2)
Rehearsals are Saturdays, 10:30-11:30 AM
Carol Choir (Children in Grades 3-6) Rehearsals are Wednesdays, 7 PM

Handbell Choir (Adult & Youth)

Ring bells once a month for the 8:15 & 10:45 AM services. Open to anyone who can read music. Rehearsals are Thursdays, 6:30-7:30 PM

Wesley Singers

Sing in local retirement homes with this men's choir.

Contemporary Worship Band

Lead worship as a singer or instrumentalist for the 9:30 AM Contemporary Service.

Worship Visuals *

Arrange seasonal decorations as well as other aesthetics that will enhance the worship experience.

MISSION & OUTREACH

Caring Connections

Connect with at home members through monthly visits, cards, and/or phone calls.

Meals for Mothers & Others

Make and deliver meals as needed for new moms and others recovering from health issues.

Prayer Shawls

Make blankets to be given to those who are ill, grieving, or to children celebrating a baptism.

Mission & Outreach Team

Create a plan for mission and outreach locally and globally through fundraising and service opportunities.

Grocery Cards

Sell grocery cards Sunday mornings to support various missions.

Green Team

Educate staff and members to take action to protect natural resources and to incorporate sustainable ideas and practices into everyday habits.

Tax Ministry

Get your taxes done by trained professionals, free of charge.

TECH TEAM

Livestream *

Operate the camera on Sunday mornings for livestreaming worship at 8:15 AM & 10:45 AM service. Training provided.

Projection *

Operate slides projected during worship for announcements, songs, scripture, at 8:15, 9:30 or 10:45 AM services. Training provided.

Sound & Light *

Operate sound and lights Sunday mornings at 8:15, 9:30 or 10:45 AM services. Training provided.

FACILITIES & OFFICE

Office Help

Greet guests during the week and do light office work as needed.


Archives

Gather and preserve essential, historical documents.

Mighty Men & Women *

Execute small repair and maintenance projects like painting, changing light bulbs and replacing ceiling tiles.
