SKILL SPOTLIGHT:

Rote Counting

What is it?

Rote counting is saying numbers in order. The numbers are not linked to counting objects or actions. Instead you are just saying a sequence of numbers, i.e. 1,2,3,4... The simplest way is to start from one and count upwards.

Why Is It Important?

Rote counting comes before the ability to count objects, or actions. You can't build a house without a foundation!

How to Develop it

For Babies and Toddlers:

- 1.) Counting stairs
- 2.) Counting songs
 - 1,2,3,4,5 – Once I Caught a Fish Alive
 - 1 Potato, 2 Potato, 3 Potato, 4
 - 1, 2, Buckle my shoe

For Preschoolers:

- 1.) Count in silly voices
- 2.) Count with a puppet
- 3.) Count past 10
- 4.) March and count

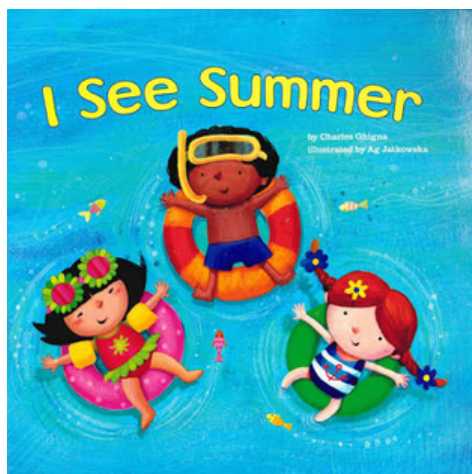
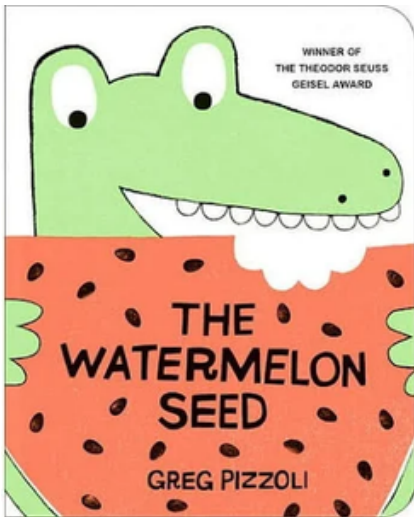
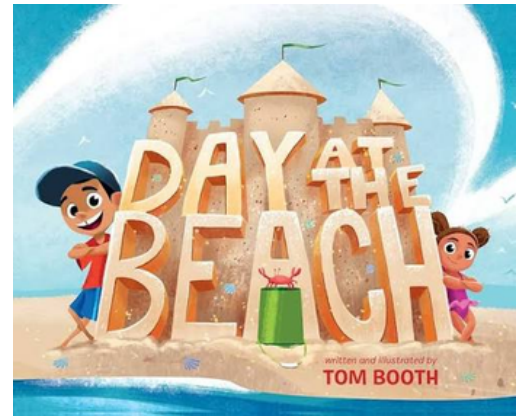
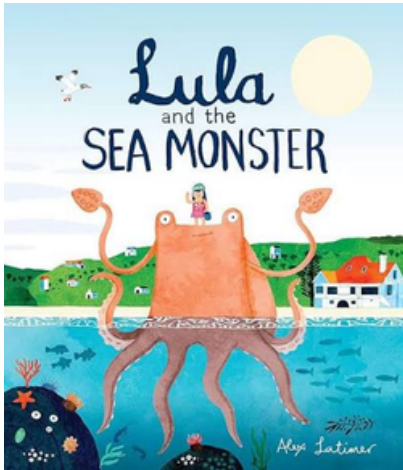


For Kindergarteners:
