

Day 22 — Unity at Camp

Scripture: “Make every effort to keep the unity of the Spirit...” — Ephesians 4:3a
Prayer: Ask God to create an atmosphere marked by love, honor, humility, and unity.

Day 23 — Protection and Safety

Scripture: “God is our refuge and our strength, an ever-present help in trouble”-Psalm 46:1
Prayer: for physical safety, emotional protection, and spiritual covering over the camp.

Day 24 — Hunger for Righteousness

Scripture: “Blessed are those who hunger and thirst for righteousness...” — Matthew 5:6a
Prayer: Ask God to stir deep spiritual hunger in students that continues beyond camp.

Day 25 — Students Far from God

Scripture: “The Son of Man came to seek and to save the lost.” — Luke 19:10
Prayer: Pray especially for students attending reluctantly, skeptically, or putting up walls.

Day 26 — Freedom from Comparison

Scripture: “I praise you because I am fearfully and wonderfully made.” — Psalm 139:14
Prayer: Pray that students would stop measuring themselves against others.

Day 27 — A Generation Set Apart

Scripture: “Don’t let anyone despise your youth, but set an example...”-1 Timothy 4:12a
Prayer: Pray that students would stand out in purity, compassion, and devotion to Jesus.

Day 28 — Faith that Lasts Beyond Camp

Scripture: “Be doers of the word and not hearers only.” — James 1:22
Prayer: Ask God to help students carry what He does at camp back into daily life.

Day 29 — Families and Homes

Scripture: “As for me and my house, we will serve the Lord.” — Joshua 24:15
Prayer: Pray for God’s blessing on parents, guardians, and families represented at camp.

Day 30 — Montana’s Next Generation

Scripture: “One generation will declare your works to the next.” — Psalm 145:4
Prayer: Pray that God would raise up a passionate generation of students across Montana

Day 31 — Lasting Revival

Scripture: “Will you not revive us again so that your people may rejoice in you?”-Psalm 85:6
Prayer: Ask God for lasting revival in students, churches, schools, families, and communities throughout Montana.

Day 1 — Hearts Ready for God

Scripture: “Draw near to God, and he will draw near to you.” — James 4:8

Prayer: Pray that every student would arrive at camp spiritually open and hungry for God.

Day 2 — Salvation and New Life

Scripture: “For everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved.” — Romans 10:13

Prayer: Ask Jesus to reveal Himself clearly to students who do not yet know Him.

Day 3 — Freedom from Shame

Scripture: “So if the Son sets you free, you will be free indeed.” — John 8:36

Prayer: Pray that students carrying shame, addiction, or hidden sin would encounter Jesus.

Day 4 — Hearing God’s Voice

Scripture: “My sheep hear my voice; I know them, and they follow me.” — John 10:27

Prayer: Ask God to help students recognize His voice with clarity and confidence.

Day 5 — A Love for God’s Word

Scripture: “Your word is a lamp to my feet and a light to my path.” — Psalm 119:105

Prayer: Pray that students would discover that God’s Word speaks directly into their lives.

Day 6 — Courage to Open Up

Scripture: “Carry one another’s burdens; in this way you fulfill the law of Christ.” —Gal. 6:2

Prayer: Pray that students would feel safe to share struggles, pain, and questions.

Day 7 — Healing from Trauma

Scripture: “He heals the brokenhearted and binds up their wounds.” — Psalm 147:3

Prayer: Lift up students walking through grief, abuse, anxiety, rejection, or family pain.

Day 8 — Baptized in the Holy Spirit

Scripture: “You will receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you.” — Acts 1:8

Prayer: Pray they would experience His presence, power, gifts, and boldness in fresh ways.

Day 9 — Freedom to Worship

Scripture: “Where the Spirit of the Lord is, there is freedom.” — 2 Corinthians 3:17

Prayer: Pray for an atmosphere of authentic worship at camp, asking God to remove fear.

Day 10 — Friendships that Strengthen Faith

Scripture: “As iron sharpens iron, so one person sharpens another.” — Proverbs 27:17

Prayer: Pray for healthy friendships to form during camp—relationships that encourage students to follow Jesus long after summer camp ends.

Day 11 — Purity and Integrity

Scripture: “Blessed are the pure in heart, for they will see God.” — Matthew 5:8

Prayer: Ask God to strengthen students against temptation and compromise.

Day 12 — Identity in Christ

Scripture: “See what great love...that we should be called children of God!” — 1 John 3:1

Prayer: Pray that students would understand their worth and identity are rooted in Christ.

Day 13 — Boldness in Faith

Scripture: “For God has not given us a spirit of fear...” — 2 Timothy 1:7a

Prayer: Pray for courage for students to live publicly and confidently for Jesus.

Day 14 — Forgiveness and Reconciliation

Scripture: “Be kind and compassionate to one another, forgiving each other...” — Eph. 4:32a

Prayer: Ask God to help students release bitterness and forgive those who have hurt them.

Day 15 — Joy in God’s Presence

Scripture: “In your presence there is fullness of joy.” — Psalm 16:11

Prayer: Pray that students would experience the genuine joy of walking with Jesus.

Day 16 — Freedom from Anxiety

Scripture: “Cast all your anxiety on him because he cares for you.” — 1 Peter 5:7

Prayer: Pray for students burdened by fear, pressure, depression, or uncertainty.

Day 17 — Servant Hearts

Scripture: “The greatest among you will be your servant.” — Matthew 23:11

Prayer: Pray that students would grow in humility and compassion, loving others like Jesus.

Day 18 — Calling and Purpose

Scripture: “For we are God’s handiwork, created in Christ Jesus to do good works.”-Eph. 2:10

Prayer: Ask God to awaken purpose in students’ lives. Pray that students respond to His call.

Day 19 — Future Pastors and Missionaries

Scripture: “Then I heard the voice of the Lord saying: Who should I send? — Isaiah 6:8a

Prayer: Pray for students who may be sensing a call to vocational ministry.

Day 20 — Marketplace Missionaries

Scripture: “Whatever you do, do it from the heart, as something done for the Lord.”-Col. 3:23

Prayer: Pray that students would understand every career can be used for God’s glory.

Day 21 — Leaders and Counselors

Scripture: “Watch over yourselves and all the flock.” — Acts 20:28

Prayer: Pray for pastors, counselors, and cabin leaders serving at camp.
