

# Heaven, Hell & Here: Here

May 10, 2026 | Corinthians 15:1-34

## **Why is the resurrection of the dead important for us Here?**

1. The resurrection of Jesus is the gospel (vs 3-7).
2. The resurrection of Jesus is the engine that drives our witness (14; 30-32).
3. The resurrection of Jesus saves us (17).
4. The resurrection of Jesus is the basis for a living hope (20-23).
5. The resurrection of Jesus fuels our holiness (32-34).

# Life Group Prep

We encourage you to reflect on and write out answers to these questions before you meet with your life group to discuss the Sunday message.

1. Read I Corinthians 15:1-34 and review the sermon. What thought, idea or concept most stands out to you from this passage?
2. Summarize the Gospel (good news) about Jesus that you understood when you became a believer. Read verses 3-7 together, and reflect on this sermon series. Does this emphasis on the resurrection of Jesus (and of the dead) change how you think about the Gospel? In what ways?
3. How might the resurrection of the dead change the way you witness to others about Jesus?
4. Jake used the analogy of learning a foreign language with the development of and practice of holiness for your life in the New Heavens and New Earth. What things do you need to practice to be at home in the New Creation?
5. Read Romans 6:1-11. In what ways does our union with Jesus through baptism lead to the participation of His Resurrected life.
