The GOSPEL is the good news about what Jesus Christ has done to reconcile sinners to God.

GOD

God is the creator of all things.

“In the beginning, God created the heavens and the earth.” Genesis 1:1

He is perfectly holy, worthy of all worship, and will punish sin. (1 John 1:5, Rev. 4:11, Rom. 2:5-8).

MAN

All people, though created good, have become sinful by nature. (Gen. 1:26-28, Ps. 51:5, Rom. 3:23). From birth, all people are alienated from God, hostile to God, and subject to the wrath of God (Eph. 2:1-3).

CHRIST

Jesus Christ, who is fully God and fully man, lived a sinless life, died on the cross to bear God’s wrath in the place of all who would believe in him, and rose from the grave in order to give his people eternal life (John 1:1, 1 Tim. 2:5, Heb. 7:26, Rom. 3:21-26, 2 Cor. 5:21, 1 Cor. 15:20-22).

RESPONSE

God calls everyone everywhere to repent of their sins and trust in Christ in order to be saved (Mark 1:15, Acts 20:21, Rom. 10:9-10).

I appeal to you therefore, brothers, by the mercies of God, to present your bodies as a living sacrifice, holy and acceptable to God, which is your spiritual worship. Do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewal of your mind, that by testing you may discern what is the will of God, what is good and acceptable and perfect.

Romans 12:1-2

BIBLICAL WORSHIP

Knowing Jesus shapes how we **worship**.

As we dive into God's Word, we encounter Jesus, the King at the center of everything. We learn His teachings and adapt our lives to follow His path, especially within the supportive community of the local church. This deeper understanding of Jesus reveals our purpose, the "why" behind our existence.

Worship becomes a **response** to this journey of discovery.

Through God's Word, we recognize our own shortcomings. We meet Jesus and the amazing grace of the gospel - his life, death, and resurrection that offer salvation. This encounter leads us to worship - a worship restored by Jesus himself. It's a beautiful connection: the saving God revealed in the gospel, the church built on that gospel message, and the world yearning for its light.

BIBLICAL CHURCH MEMBERSHIP

The case for church membership is nowhere argued in the New Testament, but everywhere assumed. It is seen in the nature of salvation, in the commands given to Christians, in the relationship between Christians and their leaders, and in the nature of the church itself.

WORSHIP IS A LIFESTYLE

Why Church Membership

- The call to **salvation** is also a call to church membership.
(1 Peter 2:5)
- Church membership is also implied in the **commands** given to Christians.
(Heb. 10:25, 1 Cor. 12:7, Eph. 4:12)
- *Believers* are also commanded to hold one another **accountable**.
(1 Cor. 5:11-12)
- The necessity of church membership is seen in the reciprocal relationships of **believers** and their **leaders**.
(1 Thes. 5:12-13, Hebrews 13:17)
- The biblical idea of church membership is rooted in the image of the church as a **body**.
(1 Cor. 12, 1 Corinthians 6:15-17, Ephesians 5:30)
- Another way of understanding church membership is in light of the church as an outpost or **embassy** of the kingdom of God.
(Phil. 3:20; 1 Pet. 2:11, Eph. 2:19, Matt. 18:18)
- Another New Testament image of the church is that of a **family**.
(Gal. 6:10; Eph. 2:19; 1 Tim 3:15).

Requirements for Membership

Trinity Baptist Church requires the following aspects for membership:

1. Personal saving faith in the person and work of Jesus Christ
2. Follow in believer's baptism by immersion
3. Agreement with the beliefs and practices of Trinity Baptist Church as they align with Scripture
4. Transfer of membership from another church of like faith and order
5. Receive congregational affirmation

Responsibilities of Members

Church members are to love, forgive, bear with, pray for, watch over, encourage, teach, admonish, build up, and serve one another in a variety of ways.

- Participate in the **life** and **ministry** of the church by regularly attending the weekly worship service, engaging in small group Bible study, and serving those inside and outside the church.
- **Give** cheerfully, faithfully, and generously, financially supporting the work of the gospel through this local church.
- Protect the **unity** of the church by acting in love towards other members, refusing to gossip, and following pastoral leadership.
- **Commit** to following Jesus with the help of the Holy Spirit as you **study** the Bible, **pray**, and **gather** with other believers.

GENEROSITY IS OUR RESPONSE

*For we are his workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand, that we should walk in them.
Ephesians 2:10*

GIVING

Giving is an **outward expression** of acknowledging that everything belongs to God, that he has given you all that you have, that he will provide for your needs, and that he wants to bless you and lead you into a closer walk with him.

Scripture is clear that we are to give **cheerfully** (2 Cor 9:7), within our means (2 Cor 8:12), and in **response** to God's immeasurable gift to us of his Son (2 Cor 8:9). We are called, then, to be sacrificial in our giving, as God has been to us. Often this is not easy, and requires us to continually seek God's will for our finances and obey his leading.

As we journey together towards becoming committed disciples of Christ, we invite you to give **regularly** and **generously** to see lives transformed by the gospel in our community and around the world.

As you are faithful in your giving, we want you to know that church leadership is committed to pursuing transparency, accountability, integrity, and excellence in stewarding the resources God has entrusted to us.
