Jesus told the disciples that he was going away and they would be sad. Then, after a while, he would return, and they would be glad.



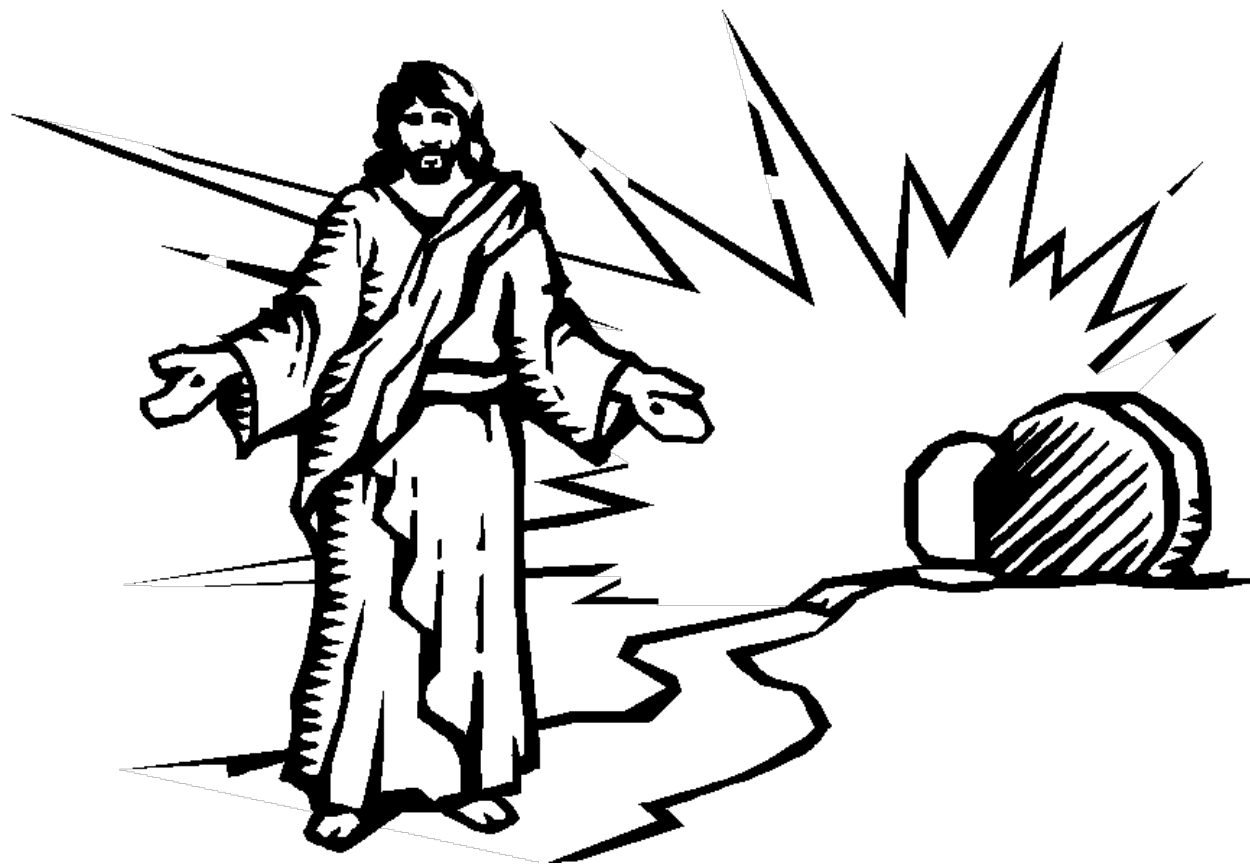
The disciples were confused and afraid to ask Jesus what he meant.

John 16:17 KJVS

[17] Then said some of his disciples among themselves, What is this that he saith unto us, A little while, and ye shall not see me: and again, a little while, and ye shall see me: and, Because I go to the Father?

Jesus told the disciples several times that he was going away. They did not understand what Jesus was talking about. Jesus was going to die on the cross for our sins and then come back to life.

Jesus Would Comfort His Disciples Upon His Return



John 16:22-24 KJVS

[22] And ye now therefore have sorrow: but I will see you again, and your heart shall rejoice, and your joy no man taketh from you. [23] And in that day ye shall ask me nothing. Verily, verily, I say unto you, Whatsoever ye shall ask the Father in my name, he will give it you. [24] Hitherto have ye asked nothing in my name: ask, and ye shall receive, that your joy may be full.

Sorrow is extreme sadness; they would see Jesus die.

Jesus Cared for and Loved His Disciples



John 16:25-28 KJVS

[25] These things have I spoken unto you in proverbs: but the time cometh, when I shall no more speak unto you in proverbs, but I shall shew you plainly of the Father. [26] At that day ye shall ask in my name: and I say not unto you, that I will pray the Father for you: [27] For the Father himself loveth you, because ye have loved me, and have believed that I came out from God. [28] I came forth from the Father, and am come into the world: again, I leave the world, and go to the Father.

Have you ever had something happen that you did not understand at first? Then later, you understood. Jesus was preparing his disciples for what was to come when he went to the cross.

Jesus said he would not leave us alone.

John 14:15-16 KJVS

[15] If ye love me, keep my commandments. [16] And I will pray the Father, and he shall give you another Comforter, that he may abide with you for ever;

I Have Peace From Jesus (John 14:27)

John 14:27 KJVS

[27] Peace I leave with you, my peace I give unto you: not as the world giveth, give I unto you. Let not your heart be troubled, neither let it be afraid.

Jesus told the disciples, and the Bible reminds us that we will have trouble sometimes. With the help of Jesus, we will overcome it.

John 16:33 KJVS

[33] These things I have spoken unto you, that in me ye might have peace. In the world ye shall have tribulation: but be of good cheer; I have overcome the world.
