



John 14 Personal Study Guide

Theme: Peaceful Hearts. Connected Lives. Empowered Lives

Main Truth: Because we are in Christ and Christ is in us, we can live with peace, obedience, and Spirit-powered fruitfulness.

Background

John 14 takes place in the Upper Room the night before the crucifixion. The disciples are troubled because Jesus has told them He is leaving.

This chapter answers three questions:

- How do we handle fear and uncertainty?
- How do we stay connected to Jesus?
- How do we live effectively after He is gone?

What did Philip ask Jesus?

How did Jesus describe His relationship with the Father?

What does Jesus promise about 'greater works'?

Where have you been trying to live in your own strength?

What would it look like to rely more on prayer?

Section 3 — Love That Obeys (John 14:15–19)

How does Jesus define love?

What does Jesus promise to send?

What role does the Holy Spirit play?

Which command is the Holy Spirit prompting you to obey?

One act of obedience I will take this week:

Section 4 — Union With Christ (John 14:20–24)

Where are you trying to live for Christ instead of letting Christ live through you?
