PREPARE AHEAD

- ✓ Prepare your belongings, clothing, Bible, water bottle, and ministry items the night before.
- ✓ Pack what you need for the day.
- ✓ Double-check medications, chargers, and essentials.
- ✓ Personal responsibility begins with personal preparation.



FOLLOW THE SCHEDULE

- ✓ Follow the daily schedule as communicated by leadership.
- ✓ Ministry opportunities are time-sensitive.
- ✓ Schedule changes can happen—stay flexible and respond with a good attitude.



IF YOU MISS TEAM TRANSPORTATION

If you are late and miss team transportation, the team will continue according to schedule.

You are responsible for arranging and paying for approved Uber/transportation to meet the group.

ACCOUNTABILITY IN ACTION



THREE-PERSON RULE

During free time, move in groups of three or more.



TELL LEADERSHIP

Let a leader know where your group is going and your expected return time.



STAY TOGETHER

Stay with the same three-person group for the entire time you are out.



USE APPROVED TRANSPORTATION

Use only approved transportation (uber/taxi arranged by the team) and return when instructed.



BE BACK ON TIME

Return to the hotel before the announced time. Curfew times will be given for each day.

HOTEL BOUNDARIES



OUR HOTEL IS OUR HOME BASE.

It is where we rest, regroup, and prepare for ministry.



ROOM BOUNDARY RULE

Men may not enter women's rooms. Women may not enter men's rooms.



TEAM CONVERSATIONS

Team conversations and meetings should take place in approved common areas.



WHY IT MATTERS

These boundaries protect you, your teammates, and our witness. They honor Christ and the people we serve.

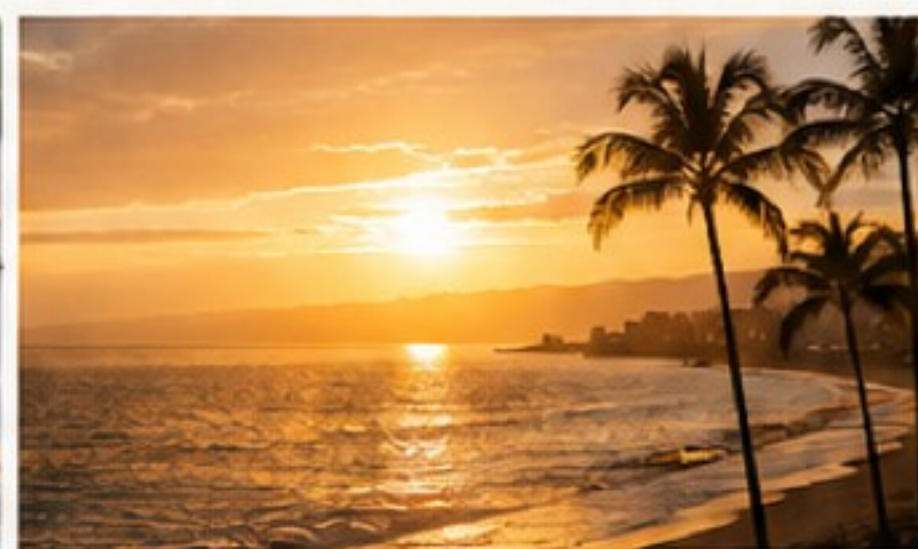

PLEASE READ CAREFULLY BEFORE YOU DECIDE TO PARTICIPATE.

This is a mission trip, not a vacation. It requires commitment, flexibility, and sacrifice.



YOU'RE INVITED!

We invite anyone interested in learning more about the **March 16–23, 2027** Puerto Vallarta Mission Trip to attend our informational meeting. We will share full details about the trip, schedule, cost, expectations, and how to apply.



TEAM SIZE IS LIMITED

Our team size is limited to ensure effective ministry, safety, and quality of experience. Priority will be given to first-time participants. Returning team members will be considered based on team needs and space availability.



APPLICATION & SELECTION PROCESS

All interested participants must complete an application. Leadership will review each application and make selections based on a balance of experience, team needs, and available space.



THIS TRIP IS VIGOROUS

You must be in good physical health and prepared for an active week of ministry.



- Expect a lot of walking on uneven surfaces, hills, stairs, and in hot/humid weather.
- We will be on our feet for long periods of time.
- Lifting, carrying, setting up, and tear down of equipment and supplies is required.
- If you have a major physical condition, injury, or mobility limitation, please honestly assess your ability to keep up with the team.
- This is not a trip where you can “take it easy” or sit out most activities.

PLEASE CONSIDER CAREFULLY BEFORE YOU APPLY.

You should be able to fully participate in the schedule and ministry opportunities throughout the week. If you have questions about your ability to participate, please talk to the leadership team before applying.

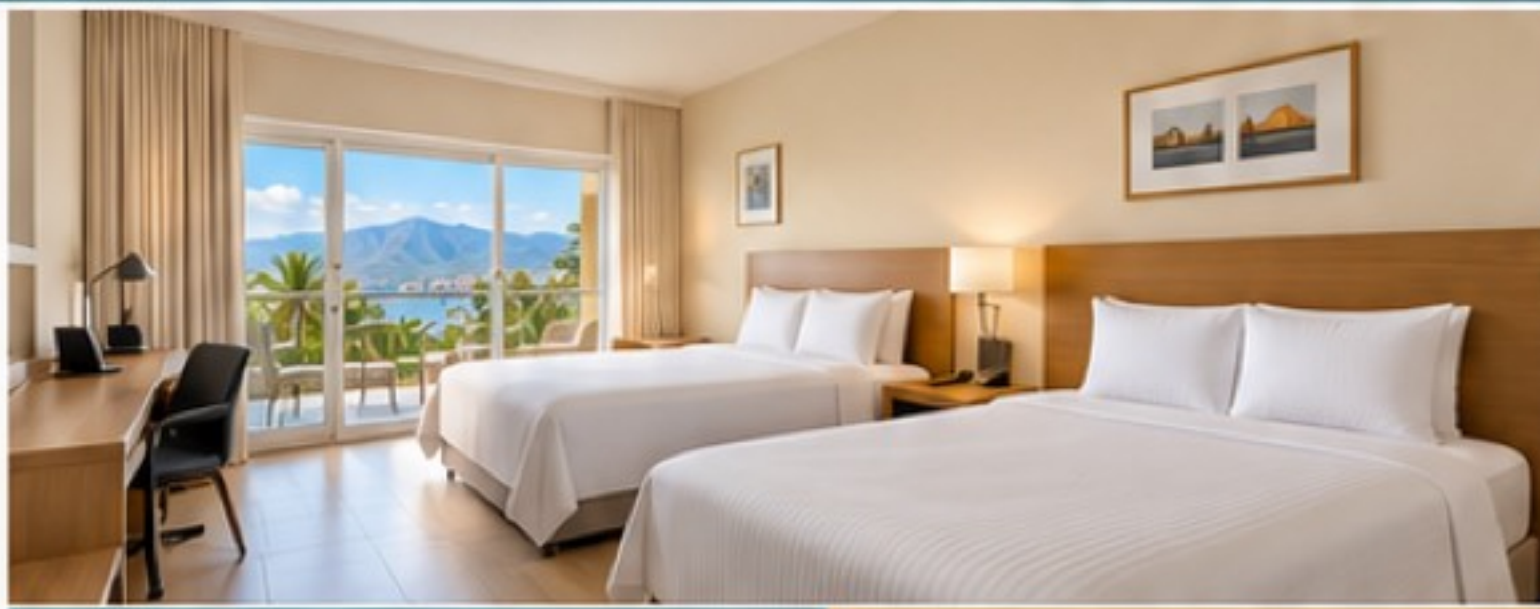

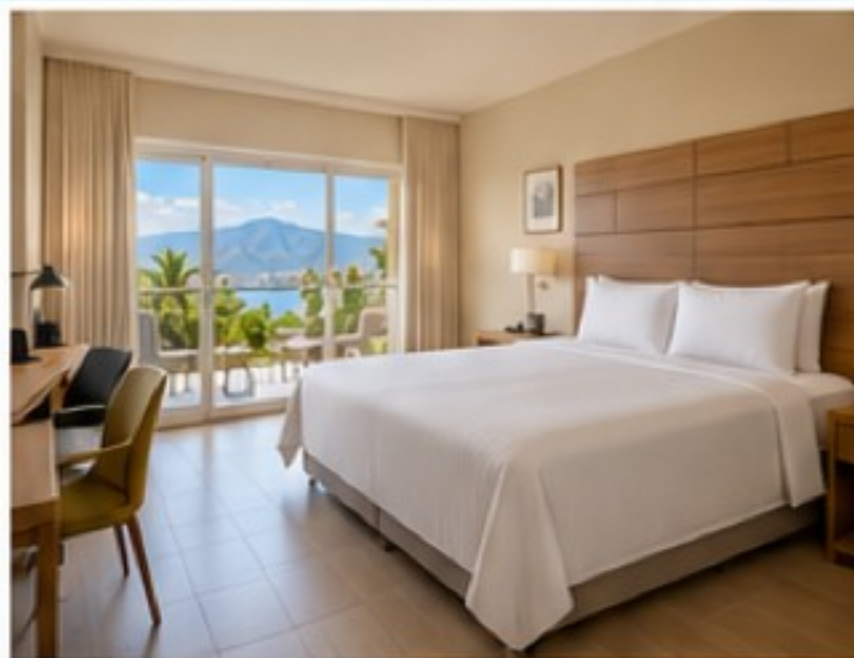
