- 3<sup>rd</sup> Pray to have understanding and clarity of the Scripture you will read and hear.**
- 4<sup>th</sup> Read the chapter(s) ..... Read the questions again.**
- 5<sup>th</sup> Listen to the message and answer the questions as you listen & read along.**
- 6<sup>th</sup> Take notes and write down any questions you may have. Save these questions and discuss  
it with your group. Find your answer in the Bible or it's not an answer!**
- 7<sup>th</sup> In one sentence on the last line write a summary of what you have read and heard.**
