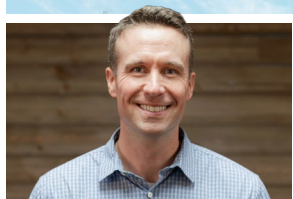

He wanted them to see that the true power behind his preaching was prayer. The same is true for our church: prayer is the power source of our ministry.
