

The offerings for the month of February will go to our Hearts for Jeus project, A New Children's Carepoint in Magoro, Uganda.



SINGING IN CHURCH



This Sunday, March 1st, K-5 students will sing at the worship service and St. Paul's handbells will play to celebrate Lutheran Schools Week.

The BOE & Finance Committee are still finalizing 2026-2027 Rates.




WINE TASTING -SAVE THE DATE




