I will need a copy of your completed certificate of this training before I can submit our agreement with Student Life. This is a new requirement, but given the world that we now live in, this is understandable. The training will require you to set up an account with life way online with a password, watch several videos and take a test. Finally upon completion you will need to print our your "Certificate of Completion" and give me a copy for our agreement.
