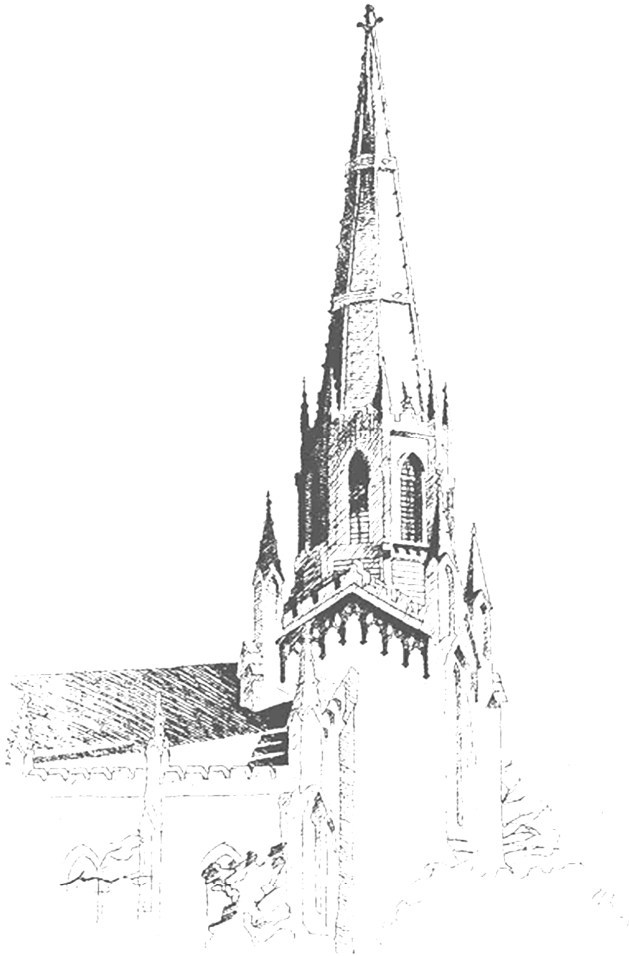

The **Columbia International University (CIU) Prison Initiative** is an accredited associate degree program for inmates to train them to serve in the South Carolina Department of Corrections. Upon graduation, student inmates serve under the leadership of the chaplain assigned to each institution. The CIU Prison Initiative has graduated 195 students who serve 21 institutions in South Carolina.

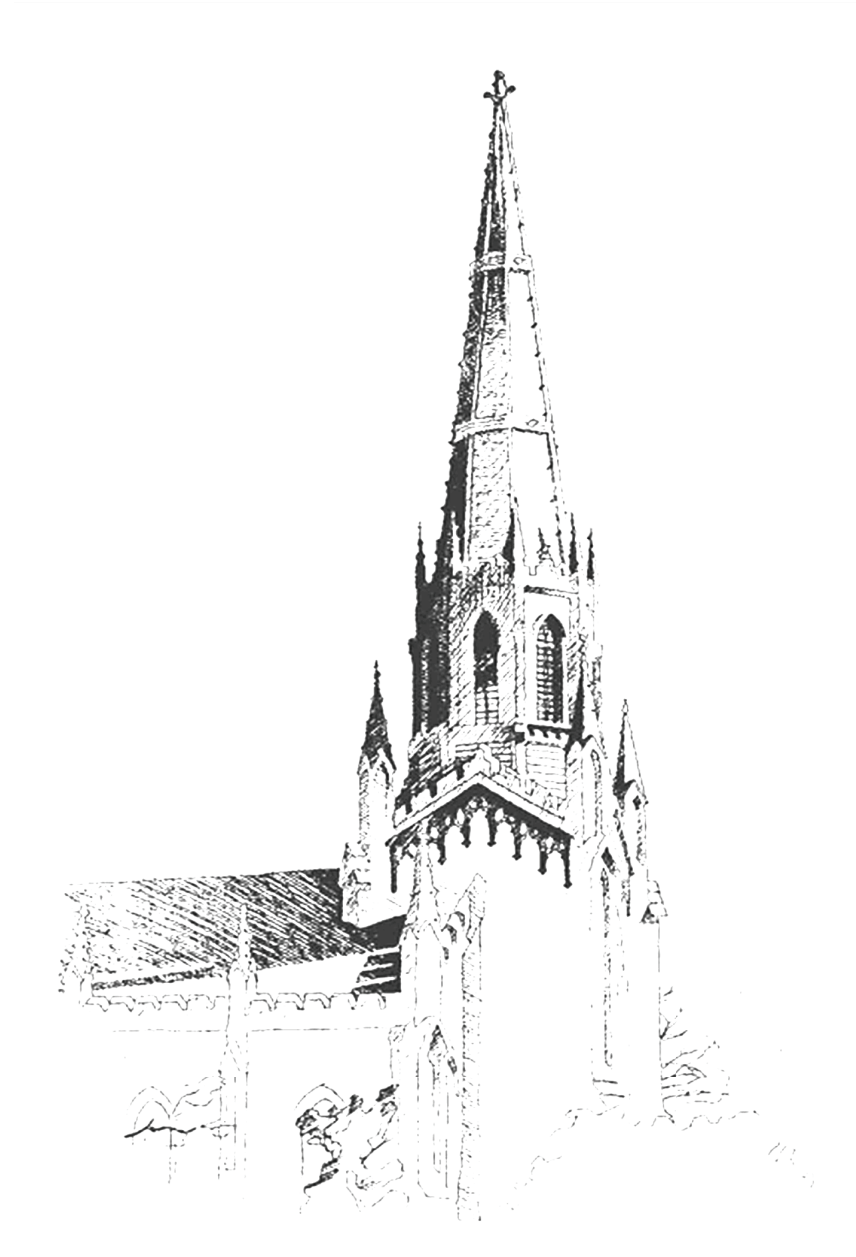
ANNOUNCEMENTS
