

Summer Camp Security (Unarmed)

PURPOSE: The Summer Camp Security provides direct supervision to the campus of SJMBC during the hours of operation.

QUALIFICATIONS:

- 1. High school diploma or equivalent preferred.
- 2. Minimum age eighteen (18).
- 3. Ability to maintain effective working relationships with students and school staff.
- 4. Demonstrated ability to work with diverse groups, and effectively communicate, both orally and in writing.
- 5. Ability to successfully pass a required criminal background screening

PERFORMANCE RESPONSIBILITIES

Essential Functions:

- 1. Ensures proper control of authorized access to an assigned school site.
- 2. Patrols summer camp buildings, facilities and grounds to ensure the presence of only authorized persons within facility perimeter.
- 3. Observes campers' behavior before, during and after summer camp hours for the purpose of ensuring appropriate behavior, reporting disturbances and resolving minor altercations.
- 4. Questions summer campers that are not in camp group session/blocks to ensure appropriate authorization to be outside the classroom; takes corrective action accordingly.
- 5. Identifies and reports any safety or security issues to summer camp director; assists in resolving such when within scope of capabilities.
- 6. Assists summer camp staff with maintaining order and protocol during summer camp activities, e.g., hall monitor, lunch, departures, parent pickup.
- 7. Escorts summer camp site visitors / parents to appropriate destinations.

Additional Job Functions:

- 1. Follows adopted policies and procedures in accordance with School Board priorities.
- 2. Conducts oneself in the best interest of students, in accordance with the highest traditions of public education and in support of the District's Mission Statement.
- 3. Performs other duties as assigned.
