

## **Clover Road Christian Church Day Camp Registration Info for Grades K-1**

1. Day Camp will be held from 9:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. on June 6<sup>th</sup> for children completing grades K-1 in May of 2026 at Camp Inlow, which is in Philadelphia, MO.
2. The goal of Day Camp is for children and parents to be comfortable and familiar with camp as the child gets older and gets to stay for a week.
3. Each child must have 1 person attend Day Camp with them and the max is 2 people. The first person must be over 18 and can be a parent, grandparent, aunt/uncle, or older sibling. The second person must be over 13 and can include a parent, grandparent, aunt/uncle, older sibling, or family friend.
4. The camp fee is \$15 per child and \$10 per guest. The camp fee includes lunch, activities, a T-shirt, and a camp video. Please make checks payable to Clover Road Christian Church and put camp on the memo line. You can also pay online at [cloverroad.org/children](http://cloverroad.org/children).

6. Please fill out the online registration form and pay the camp fee by May 17<sup>th</sup>. Registration will be accepted after May 17<sup>th</sup>, but I cannot guarantee you will receive a camp T-shirt.
7. Confirmation of registration and updates regarding Day Camp will be sent to the email address(es) you list on the online form.
8. If your child wants to be baptized at camp, please let me know by May 31. We will do the baptisms on Saturday, the 6<sup>th</sup>, at 4:15 p.m.
9. Each child and person attending should bring the following items to camp. Keep in mind, our clothes may get dirty.
  - \* Bible (we have Bibles you can use)
  - \* Pen/Pencil
  - \* Swim Towel
  - \* Swimsuit (see rule #11)
  - \* Lifejacket/Goggles (optional)
  - \* Extra Set of Clothes (just in case)
  - \* Ball Glove (optional)
  - \* Flip Flops for Pool Time
  - \* Pillow/Sleeping Bag or Blanket (short period to lay down and rest)
  - \* Insect Repellent
  - \* Sun Block
  - \* Wear Tennis Shoes or Approved Sandals (see rule #10)

## Clover Road Christian Church Camp Rules

We do not want to burden the camper with excessive rules, but it is necessary that we have a common understanding of a few of the principles that guide our camp. The principles listed below are applicable to campers, volunteers, and all visitors.

1. All campers must be courteous and respectful of other campers, the camp staff, and belongings.
2. Every person is required to follow the camp schedule.
3. Every person must be present at all activities unless special circumstances arise, and permission is given by the camp dean.
4. Every person must remain on camp grounds unless the camp dean gives permission.
5. The use of tobacco, vapes, drugs, and alcohol is strictly prohibited.
6. Vehicles may be driven only at specified times at camp.
7. Illness and injury must be reported to the camp dean immediately.
8. Swimming is only allowed during the supervised scheduled recreation time.
9. Clothing must be appropriate for our Christian camp.
  - Do not wear clothing with inappropriate logos
  - No short shorts
  - Tank tops must have straps at least 2 inches wide
  - Do not wear clothing that shows undergarments
10. Tennis shoes or approved sandals must be worn for all camp activities except for swim time. Flip Flops are allowed for pool time. Approved Sandals: secured to the feet so they will not fall off when running. We do a lot of running around and we want to protect our feet from bees and debris.
11. Both one and two piece swimsuits are allowed as long as a **dark** t-shirt is worn by girls with two piece swimsuits. Tankinis are allowed without a t-shirt only if the top and bottom meet and the stomach is covered. Boys are not allowed to wear speedos. If you have any questions, talk to the camp dean. These are the rules of Camp Inlow that we must adhere to.
12. Do not bring the following items: any type of electronics, water guns, water balloons, pocket knives, and other items that would distract from camp activities and growing close to God. These items will be confiscated by the camp dean and returned when Day Camp is over. If you have any questions about an item, have it pre-approved by the camp dean.

The camp dean reserves the right to dismiss any camper who does not conform to the rules of the camp.
