



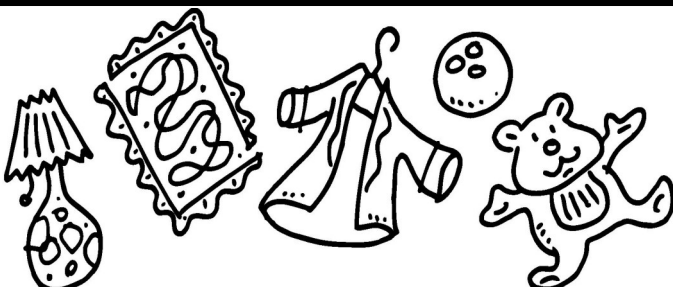

Tell us a little about yourself. My wife, Danielle, and I have been married for almost 15 years and we have two kids, Levi (10) and Olivia (5). I grew up in Mexico, where my parents were missionaries for over 40 years and I took a long and circuitous route into IT work. I've played guitar and bass since high school and have been a part of church and ministry worship teams since 2001.

Where do you serve & how long have you been serving in this role? Worship team since summer of 2024 and mowing team since summer of 2025.

How has serving at CRCC had an impact on you? I think one of the most important things we can do as a part of God's family is to serve each other. 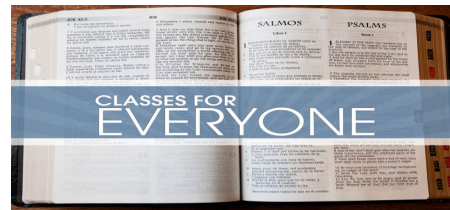
HANDS AND FEET
