DAY 2: SMALL THINGS MATTER

Read Matthew 13:31–32 Nlrv

God's Kingdom doesn't always look big or impressive at first. Sometimes it starts with something so small that people barely notice. But God loves using small beginnings to do great things. God celebrates starts, not just finishes. You don't have to wait until you're older, louder, or braver. Jesus shows us that God's Kingdom often begins with small steps taken in faith.

DAY 3: GOD'S KINGDOM GROWS INSIDE YOU

Read Luke 17:20–21 Nlrv

God's Kingdom is not just something we see one day in the future. Jesus showed us that God's Kingdom begins in our hearts. When you choose love, patience, or kindness, God's Kingdom is growing inside you.

Sometimes growth is slow, like waiting for dough to rise. You can't rush it, but you can trust that God is working. Even when you don't feel different right away, God's Spirit is shaping you to be more like Jesus. Following Jesus means letting God change you from the inside out so His love can shine through you.

DAY 4: GOD WORKS THROUGH YOU

Read Colossians 1:27 Nlrv

When you follow Jesus, God invites you to be part of His Kingdom story. That means God doesn't just work around you. He works through you. Jesus shows us what God's Kingdom looks like through everyday people doing everyday things with love. God can use your words, actions, and choices to bring hope to your school, your family, and your neighborhood.

DAY 5: LIVING THE KINGDOM STORY
Read Romans 14:17 NIrV

God's Kingdom is not about power, fame, or winning. Jesus shows us that God's Kingdom is about living God's way every day. When you choose what is right, love others, and trust God, you're living out the Kingdom story. God is still working, even when you can't see everything yet. One day, God's Kingdom will be complete. Until then, Jesus invites you to live it out wherever you go.
