Engagement Questions

- What is something you want to keep praying for?



Morning Time

When you go into your child's room, cuddle them and say: "Good morning! We can pray and talk to God anytime, anywhere, and about anything!"



Cuddle Time

Cuddle with your child and pray: "God, thank You for listening to us. Thank you that we can pray and talk to you anytime, anywhere and about anything!"



Drive Time

While on the go, look at all the different places you see. Ask, "Where can you pray and talk to God?"



Bath Time

Add a plastic figure to bath time. Have your child hide the figure in the tub in different places. Everytime you find the figure say, "Can you talk to God there? Yes! You can talk to God anywhere!"
