Talk About the Bible Story

Open the Bible together and read Luke 15:1-3, 8-10 or watch the video together on the Parent Cue app.

Engagement Questions

- Who can be a part of God's kingdom?
- Name some things you have lost but then found.



Morning Time

When you go into your child's room, cuddle them and say: "Good morning, [child's name]! You are important to God and you are important to me!"



Cuddle Time

Cuddle with your child and pray: "God, thank You for sending Jesus to teach us that we are so important to You. Help us to trust You and follow Jesus so we can be part of Your kingdom forever. In Jesus' name, Amen."



Drive Time

While on the go, look for things that are round like a coin. Do you see a tire? Do you see a pizza? Talk about how the woman lost her round coin and because it was so important to her, she looked and looked for it. Say: "Just like the coin was important to the woman, you are even more important to God!"



Bath Time

Add some bubbles and ten toys to bath time. Count the toys together. Then, hide one toy in the bubbles and ask your child to find the missing toy. Say, "You did a great job finding the missing toy. That toy is special to you and did you know, YOU are even more special to God! God loves you so much!"
