Who is eligible to take classes with Gateway?

For Those with a Bachelor's Degree...

You are eligible to apply to Gateway Seminary.

For Those without a Bachelor's Degree...

If you have a high school diploma and are 25 years of age or older, you are eligible to apply through our Master's by Exception program.



How much does it cost?



- The base cost of tuition is currently \$365 per credit hour; a three credit course is \$1095
- Most of our partnerships operate off of a third, a third, and a third agreement...
 - Gateway gives a third scholarship
 - The church, association, convention, etc. gives a third scholarship
 - The student pays a third; \$365
