SUGGESTIONS ON WHAT TO BRING:

Bible, pen/pencil, flashlight, towels for showers and for swimming, washcloth, toothbrush, toothpaste, soap, comb, bedding/sleeping bag, pillow, light jacket, sleeping attire, socks, underclothes, toiletries, swimsuit, and cover-up (dark colored shorts & shirt will need to be worn over suit to swim), shoes, TENNIS SHOES ARE A MUST, sunscreen, mosquito repellent. Please read the dress code below for more details.

CELL PHONES:

Cellphones are permitted but may have limited reception.

DO NOT BRING:

Cutaway shirts, mesh shirts, suggestive clothing, shorts that are shorter than fist length when your hands are at your side, skirts that are shorter than knee length, halter tops (navel showing), low cut shirts, fireworks, firearms, tobacco, weapons, alcohol, drugs, vape pens, pets, and any inappropriate clothing.

We reserve the right to inspect contents of all personal belongings. The holding and/or disposal of improper contents is the right of the camp staff.

DRESS CODE:

Modesty is the rule! T-shirts, jeans, capris, or shorts. Shorts MUST be at least fist length. Extremely tight and/or short garments are not allowed. No undergarments showing. Wear clothing that is cool, comfortable, and modest; and tennis shoes that are appropriate for athletic games.

VISITS AND CALLS:

Our Camps closed to visitors due to liabilities and insurance. Evening services are not open to the general public and are only opened to registered campers, leaders, and staff, as well as STXAG Credentialed Ministers. **NO VISITORS WILL BE ALLOWED.** We ask parents to limit calls to an urgent nature. Experience has proven that this often promotes homesickness and other complications.

REGISTRATION AND ROOM ASSIGNMENTS: Only registered campers, leaders and staff are permitted on the grounds. Campers will be assigned a room with their church based on age. No one will be allowed to sleep on the floor or together in one bed. **No early arrivals will be accepted.** We can not accommodate special room assignments for you or your group.

SWIM TEST:

Each camper is required by the State of Texas to complete a mandatory swim test to ensure the safety of every student during water activities. **Please arrive at church Monday morning with your bathingsuit on, under your cover-up, to take the swim test immediately upon arrival at camp.**

HEALTH RECORDS AND MEDICINE:

All medicine is to be turned into the camp First Aid Attendant upon arrival at the First Aid Station. They will dispense all medication during camp. **Parents are required to fill out the Camper Medication Form 24 hours in advance, no earlier.** This must be complete and accurate. Parents must send any updated health information and medication with the camper to camp. Please remember that the parent/legal guardian is responsible for all medical expenses incurred during camp.
