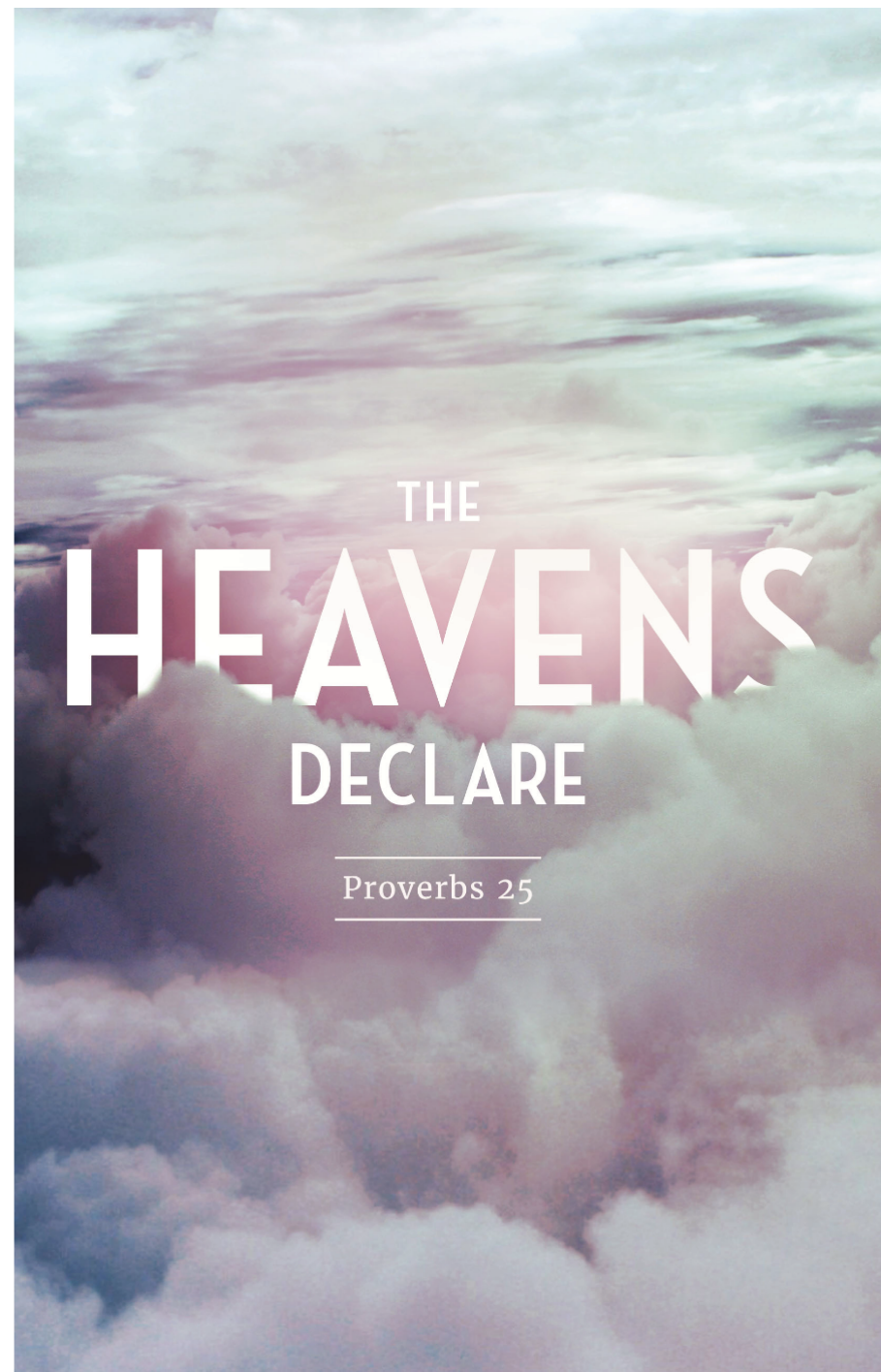
### Financial Report through February 28, 2025
