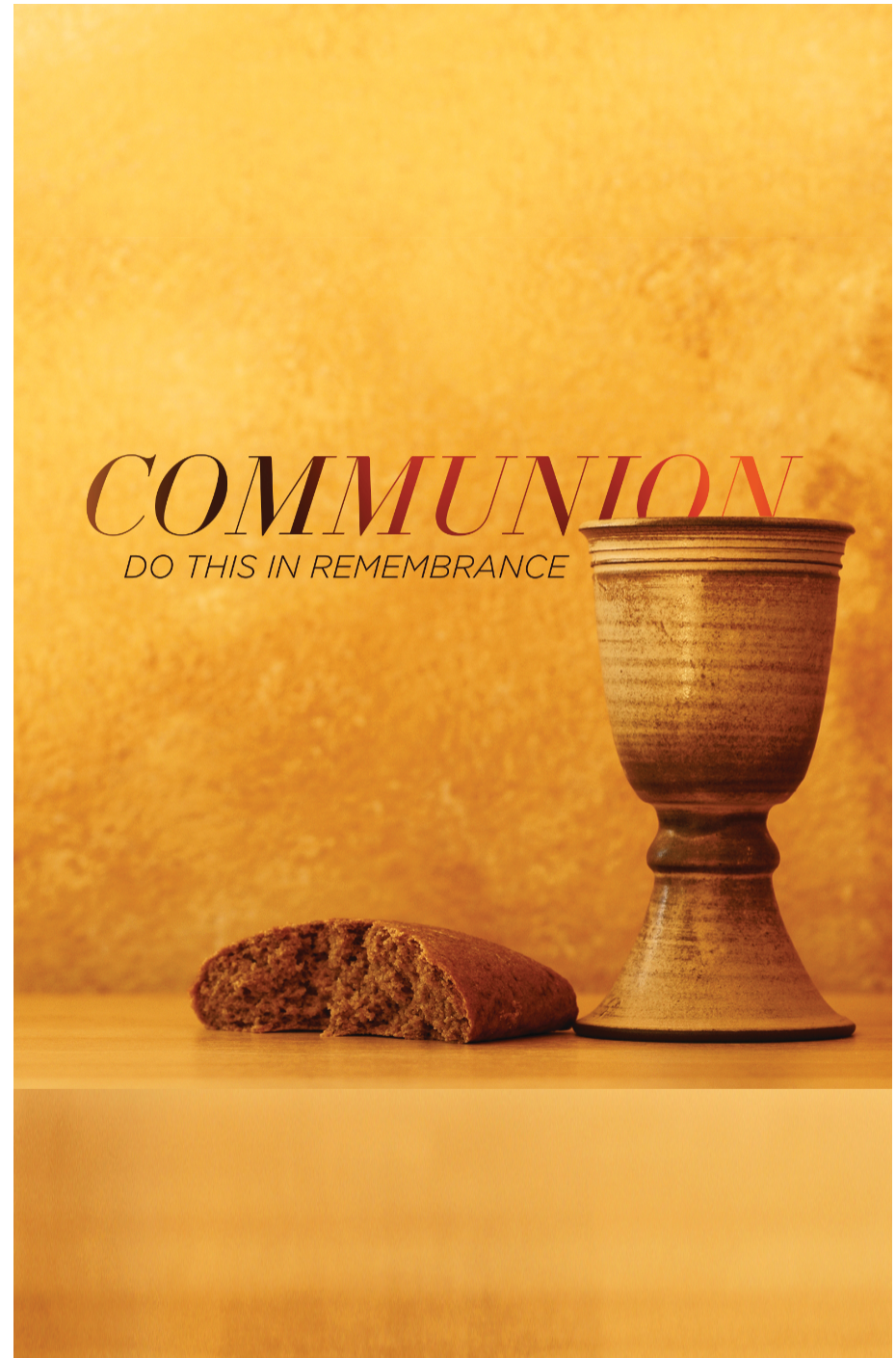
Financial Report through April 18, 2025
