WHAT TO BRING

MUST HAVES:

- 🍷 CLOTHING: Clothing for six days- t-shirts, shorts, pants, jeans, swimwear, active wear, pajamas, etc. During recreation times you may get sweaty and dirty, so please pack accordingly. **Please see the modesty guidelines at the bottom of this sheet.**
- 🍷 TOILETRIES: Toothbrush, toothpaste, deodorant, soap, shampoo, towel, wash cloth, sunscreen, etc. (Please no perfumes, body sprays, aerosol deodorant.)
- 🍷 BEDDING: Pillow, sheets and blanket, and/or sleeping bag.
- 🍷 BIBLE AND WRITING UTENSIL: If you do not have a Bible, please let us know; we will provide you with one. You will be given a student booklet at camp, but you may also want to bring your own notebook.
- 🍷 LUNCH MONEY: About \$10-\$20 to cover lunch on Monday and lunch on Saturday (on the road).
- 🍷 WATER BOTTLE: Falls Creek has a tendency to be very hot and humid. You will need to have a water bottle you can carry with you to keep yourself hydrated. Most of the students who get sick at camp are those who do not drink enough water or eat enough at mealtimes.

OPTIONAL:

- 🍷 EXTRA MONEY: There are refreshment stands and a gift shop with t-shirts and knick-knacks. Please remember, YOU ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR THE MONEY YOU BRING. Logan or Pastor Andrew will have a safe at camp in which you can keep your money, but you will only be able to retrieve your money at certain times of the day.
- 🍷 CELL PHONES: STUDENTS CAN BORROW A SPONSOR'S PHONE DURING FREE TIME TO CALL HOME. ALL MOBILE DEVICES WILL BE COLLECTED ONCE WE GET TO CAMP: ALL phones will be locked up in a storage bin for safe keeping and can be checked out during the afternoon for short periods and then returned to storage bin.

DON'T BRING:

- 🍷 EXTRA FOOD: You will be well fed at camp; there is no need to bring extra refreshments.
- 🍷 SMELLY STUFF: Please no perfumes, body spray, air fresheners, aerosol deodorant sprays.

MODESTY GUIDELINES:

Immodest dress can be extremely distracting. Because our goal at Falls Creek is to focus our hearts and minds on Jesus and to lift only Him up, we ask that you adhere to the following guidelines:

- 🍷 CLOTHING: No tight fitting clothing or clothing with writing across the rear of pants or shorts. Clothing should not display or promote alcohol, tobacco, controlled substances or inappropriate language or images. Shorts should be long enough so that when your arms are at your side they at least extend to the end of your fingertips. Shirts should not have plunging neck-lines and should not expose your midriff. Do not bring thin-strap or spaghetti-strap tank tops. Skirts and dresses should hit no higher than right above the knee.
- 🍷 SWIMWEAR: Gentleman: No tight-fitting swimwear. Ladies: A one-piece suit is preferable. If you must wear a two piece (of any kind), a navy blue or black t-shirt must be worn over it. Everyone: A cover-up and footwear must be worn to and from swimming areas.

All apparel judgements will be left to the discretion of the Falls Creek Staff (FCS). If FCS determines a camper or campers should change their clothing to fall in line with camp requirements, then said camper or campers are required to do so.

Shorts must extend to or just beyond the campers' finger tips.



Dresses/Skirts must reach the top of the knee.



Shoes must be worn at all times outside of your cabin.



T-shirts and cover-ups must be worn to and from swimming venues.

Should wear swimsuits of modest length (fingertip) and not tight fitting

Campers may not be barefoot on the way to and from venues.

SWIMWEAR

Tights may be worn under a garment that meets the dress code. Tights/sliders do not extend the length of garments worn over them (short/skirts/dresses). **Tights are not pants.** No tight fitting or revealing clothing. This includes leggings or similar attire, which cannot be worn as pants.



No tank tops or shirts cut down the sides.



Undergarments must always be covered by outer garments (i.e. no boxer shorts hanging out or bra straps showing).



No Midriifs/racer backs. No sport bras as tops (includes the 5k).



No spaghetti strap tank tops/dresses.



WHAT NOT TO WEAR

Apparel may not display tobacco, alcohol, controlled substances, or inappropriate language or pictures.

WHAT TO BRING/PACKING LIST

MEDICATIONS:

- PRESCRIPTION MEDICATIONS:** If your student requires prescription medication, please provide it **IN ITS ORIGINAL PRESCRIPTION BOTTLE OR PACKAGING** along with a note explaining in detail the dosage to be taken and the times it needs to be taken. The medication needs to be given to an adult sponsor prior to leaving the church for Falls Creek. We must have the prescription bottle/packaging for liability reasons.
- OVER THE COUNTER MEDICATIONS:** If your student requires over the counter medication to be taken on a regular basis, please follow the same instructions given above for prescription medication (i.e. send it in original packaging, send an instructional note, give to adult sponsor). Please do not send any over the counter medication with your student unless he/she needs it on a regular basis. Please understand that this is for the safety of not only your student but also the other students at camp.

LUGGAGE:

- We ask that you please pack as lightly and as tightly as you possibly can. There are many students and sponsors attending Falls Creek this year, and we want to make sure that we have enough room for everyone's luggage. Please do not exceed the following limit:
 - ☀ One large bag or suitcase.
 - ☀ One small carry-on bag.
 - ☀ One sleeping bag and one pillow.
- It is helpful to mark your bags for easier identification.

CODE OF CONDUCT FOR FALLS CREEK

(TAKEN FROM THE FALLS CREEK MANUAL)

The code of conduct for Falls Creek is intended to assist the many diverse churches and students at camp to have a safe and enjoyable camp experience, while growing in their faith. Falls Creek is designed to help students and adults know and follow God, so the code of conduct prioritizes issues related to a student's faith development in Jesus.

- * After 10:15pm, all students should be inside their cabins and should not be outside their cabins without a sponsor until after 6:30am. Groups are allowed to meet around the perimeter of their cabins during late night devotional times, but a sponsor should be with the group at all times and care should be taken not to disturb other groups.
- * Students are required to attend both the Morning and Evening Tabernacle experiences each day.
- * Students should not have cell phones or two-way radios.
- * Use or possession of illegal drugs, alcohol, or tobacco is not permitted on the grounds during any week of camp. The possession of offensive weapons of any sort is prohibited at Falls Creek. Falls Creek Baptist Conference Center reserves the right to perform a random drug and weapon search at any time and confiscate items that distract from the camp goals or that violate the code of conduct at the camp.
- * Pets/animals (other than service dogs), fireworks, rock throwing, water fighting (including water guns), laser pointers and shaving cream fights are prohibited on the grounds. Masks or any other disguise over the face cannot be worn by anyone outside of the cabins. For the safety of all guests, skates, rollerblades and skateboards are permitted only in the SwiftSkate area and only at designated times. Violation of this policy could result in confiscation of equipment.
- * No wading or swimming is allowed in the creeks or lake without a Falls Creek lifeguard present.
- * Falls Creek is a Christian environment that promotes personal encouragement and spiritual development of every camper. Falls Creek does not condone or encourage any activity on grounds that humiliates any camper, including initiation, hazing and pranks.

CODE OF CONDUCT FOR FALLS CREEK

ADDITIONAL LINCOLN AVENUE POLICIES:

- * There should be no public displays of affection (such as hand-holding, intimate hugging, kissing, etc.) between any campers, with the exception of married sponsors. A guy-girl couple (dating or otherwise) should not go anywhere on campus by themselves.
- * As Falls Creek is a very large and busy place, no camper should go anywhere on campus alone at any time during the week. Please watch out for each other and stick together.
- * In coming with Lincoln Avenue Baptist Church to Falls Creek, you are automatically agreeing to participate in all Lincoln Avenue group activities, Bible studies, worship services, etc., while at camp. You are also agreeing to be at all Lincoln Avenue functions on time and ready to participate. This is not only for your safety but also for your well-being while at camp.
