HOW DO I START A NEW MINISTRY?

An idea for a new ministry can be a one-time project or an ongoing ministry focus. These simple steps will help kick-start a new ministry and identify any support that may be needed:

1. Meet with the deacon who oversees that area to determine how the new ministry would align with KC's mission and vision. Deacon lets their elder know the process has begun.
2. If financial support is needed, determine if the deacon's existing budget is sufficient to sustain the needs of the ministry. If not, explore with the other deacons whether they have a budget surplus that could be shifted to cover the new ministry. If there is still a financial shortage, the next step is to explore with the elders whether any lines in the overall church budget could be adjusted to fund the new ministry.
3. Prospective team leader meets with the Assistant Director of Ministries to develop a ministry description, identify Spiritual gifts within the leader(s), develop goals for the ministry and ensure the ministry aligns with the mission and vision of KC. That would then establish the new team.



HOW DO I MAKE PURCHASES FOR MY MINISTRY?

Purchases must be pre-approved by your deacon and a "Ministry Team Reimbursement/Payment Authorization" form completed (located in the office).

3 ways to make purchases:

- Pay out of pocket and then get reimbursed from the church.
- Ask the Adm Asst or ADM to purchase with a church credit card.
- Ask the church to send a check to the recipient directly.

Each option needs a completed "Ministry Team Reimbursement/Payment Authorization" form.
