Day 1 | Pray for the Host Homes

- Pray that God’s light and His love will permeate these families and their homes so that the students experience the love of the Lord and the fruit of His Spirit in such a profound way that it leaves a lasting impression; that it is sealed on their minds and in their hearts. Day 4 | Pray for the Speaker
