

# 5-Day Devotional: Living In Resurrection Power

## Day 1: The Power Over Sin

Reading: Romans 6:1-14

### Devotional:

The resurrection didn't just prove Jesus conquered death—it gave you power to conquer sin.

Your old self was crucified with Christ, and you no longer have to be enslaved to destructive patterns.

**Before you sleep tonight**, review your day.

What needs a funeral? What sinful habit requires you to declare, **"I'm not doing this anymore"**?

Resurrection power means temptation no longer controls you. Yes, you'll be tempted, but God provides a way to bear it and escape.

Stop making excuses and start killing what needs to die. When Jesus called your name, He gave you real power—power to sin less today than yesterday. **Are you using it?**

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## Day 2: Freedom From The Worlds System

Reading: 1 John 2:15-17; Romans 12:1-2

### Devotional:

What you consume will eventually consume you. The world's system—its values, cravings, and pride—competes for the love that belongs to God alone.

**Ask yourself honestly:** Does the world get more of your best than the church? What shapes your thinking—culture or Scripture?

You cannot live a Spirit-filled life with a world-filled mind. Examine your entertainment, relationships, and desires.

**If Jesus stood beside you, would anything change?**

Resurrection power enables you to be in the world but not of it. You're called to be sanctified—set apart—by God's truth.

**Today,** identify one worldly influence that's blurring the lines in your walk with Christ, and by faith, the victory that overcomes the world, step away from it.

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## Day 3: Breaking Free From Your Past

Reading: Psalm 32:1-5; 2 Corinthians 5:17

### Devotional:

**Your past is something you did, not who you are.**

David discovered that hidden sin created physical and spiritual drought in his life. When he kept silent about his failures, God's hand pressed heavy upon him—not to punish, but to restore.

The moment he confessed, forgiveness came immediately.

**Are you still carrying guilt from past mistakes?** God is greater than your condemning heart. **Where sin abounds, grace abounds much more.**

The same Jesus who descended into hell and spoke power to the spirits can speak power over your past. **Stop letting yesterday define your today.** You are new in Christ—old things have passed away.

**Give your guilt to God and walk in the relief, removal, and restoration He offers.**

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## Day 4: Faith That Overcomes

Reading: 1 John 5:1-5; Hebrews 11:1-6

### Devotional:

Whatever you're struggling with in this world, put a little faith on it. Faith is the victory that overcomes the world—not willpower, not good intentions, but faith in the risen Christ.

**You're not fighting for victory; you're fighting from victory.**

Jesus already won at the cross and the empty tomb. When worldly desires tempt you, when your flesh wars against your spirit, when circumstances seem overwhelming—**activate your faith.**

Remind yourself who called your name and what power He gave you. Faith doesn't mean temptation disappears; it means temptation no longer controls you. **Today,** identify one area where you need victory and declare over it: **"Faith is my victory."** Then take one faith-filled action that demonstrates you believe God's power is greater than your problem.

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## Day 5: Walking In New Identity

Reading: Colossians 3:1-17; Ephesians 4:17-24

Devotional:

**Because He got up, you have a new identity.**

You are no longer defined by your sins, your past, or the world's labels. You are called by His name—and that changes everything.

**Put to death what belongs to your earthly nature:** sexual immorality, impurity, greed, anger, slander. These don't fit who you are anymore. Instead, clothe yourself with compassion, kindness, humility, gentleness, and patience.

Let Christ's peace rule in your heart.

**This isn't about perfection; it's about direction.** Your victories should outnumber your defeats. When you stumble, own it, reveal it to God, and kill it. Don't let another day pass without operating in resurrection power.

Jesus whispered your name at an empty tomb. You answered. Now rise and walk in the newness of life—with real power.
