If you are a little cool with the A/C on, or with cooler temperatures, there are lap blankets available to use during church. Pick one up from the baskets across the office and return it after the service.

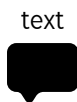

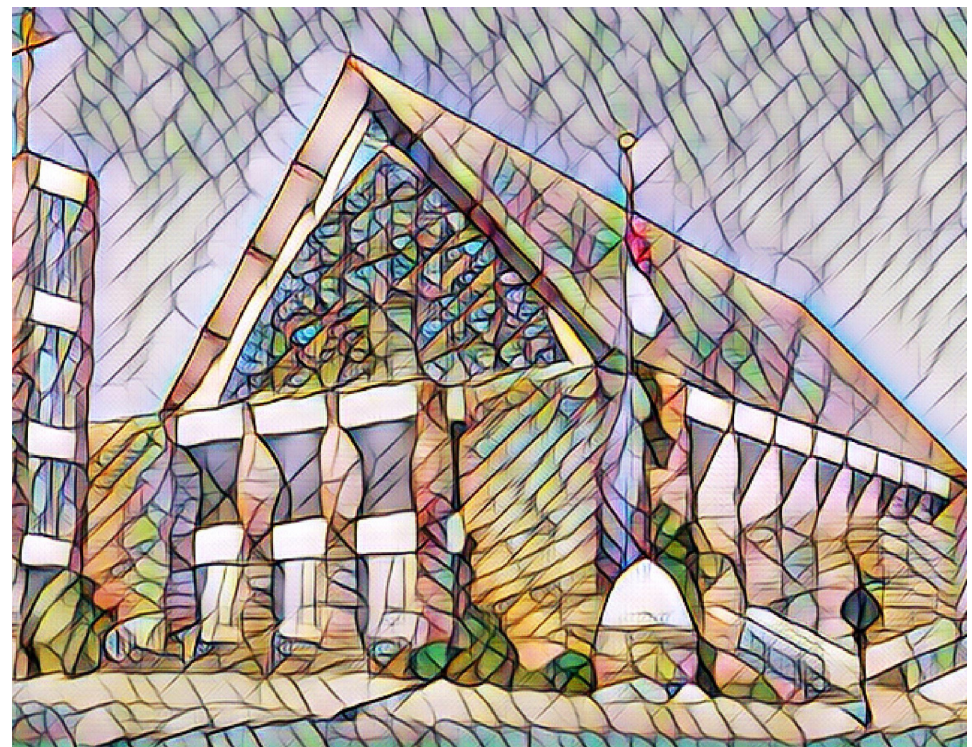
