I Am Set Apart

Leader Notes

Bible Passage: Jesus gave the great commission- Matt 28:16-20; Mark 16:15-18; Luke 24:48-52; Acts 1:4-8

Bottom Line: I can share the truth.

Leader Context: After Jesus rose from the dead but before He returned to heaven, He gave His followers a mission. (Read Acts 1:7-8.) Jesus told His disciples to share the truth "to the ends of the earth," and He tells us to do the same. Let's help kids see that they can share the truth about Jesus near and far. When they share Jesus, they can be confident they are stepping up and living set apart.

THE WIN FOR SUNDAY GROUPS: Give kids a first look at The Bible, Jesus, and our need for a Savior by embracing their physical needs or engaging their interests. Use The Code when necessary to help redirect kids and build relationships.

Games and Music (10 minutes)

What You Need: Social Game Instruction Page including Roku Games, microphone (1 per group), Music and music player (1 per group)

What You Do:

- Play worship songs and other songs available on Roku during the Social Game or while kids are playing.
- Using the supplies and game instruction page, choose one game to play with the kids today.
- As you are playing, use this as a time to call each kid by name and learn their names well.

Say: That was a fun game to get us ready to watch our Bible video. Let's sit and listen to our story today."

Bible Story Video (10 minutes)

Bible Story Recap- Say This!

Thanks so much, Super Crew! In our Bible story we learned that we can tell others about Jesus. Jesus told His friends to tell everyone about Him and to share about Him with people everywhere. Our Super Clue, a microphone, reminds us that we can share the awesome news about Jesus so that everyone can hear. We can tell our friends and family about Jesus by telling them things like Jesus loves them, Jesus is God's Son, and Jesus is very special. We can obey God by telling people about Jesus.

Great job! Let's pray and thank God for helping us obey Him. When we pray, we talk and listen to God.

God, thank You that Jesus loves us. Help us tell others that He loves them too. Thank You for helping us obey You. Amen.

Can you say the Big Deal with me?

Lead the Way! (Swipe both hands down from head to hips with hands facing each other.)

God Helps Me Obey! (Put two thumbs up.)

Make a Microphone(20 minutes)

Big Goal: Remember the Bible story.

Leader Prep: Print and cut out “Make A Microphone” printables on cardstock, one per child. Count out 10-12 peanuts for each kid, place in a zip top bag (1 set per kid)

Supplies: “Make A Microphone” printable (1 per child), Cardstock (1 per child), Markers or crayons (several), Craft Peanuts (10-12 per kid), sponge (2-3 per table), foam plate or tray (to place wet sponge on)

Craft Instructions:

1. Before the session, print and cut out “Make A Microphone” printables on cardstock, one per child.
2. Give each preschooler a microphone and markers or crayons.
3. Encourage preschoolers to decorate their microphones using the craft peanuts. Each kid will touch the peanut to the sponge. When it is wet, they will attach the peanut to the paper. Each peanut should stick without glue.

What To Do: Our Super Clue today is something that you can talk into so everyone can hear. Our Super Clue is a microphone. What’s our Super Clue? *(A microphone!)* Yes! Let’s make our own microphones. I am going to give you a paper microphone and markers or crayons. You will decorate your microphone and when we finish, we will practice saying things about Jesus in our microphones like “Jesus loves you,” “Jesus is God’s Son,” and “Jesus is very special!”

Keep It Going: Ask preschoolers about different places they can tell about Jesus. Include examples such as a family member’s house, the grocery store, and the library.

Loud And Clear: Wow! Your microphones look great! A microphone is something you can use to share a fun song or big news for everyone to hear. In our Bible story today, Jesus told His followers to tell everyone about Him. God helps us obey and share this good news everywhere we go. We said things into our microphones like “Jesus loves you,” “Jesus is God’s Son,” and “Jesus is very special!” These are things that you can use your microphone to tell your friends and family about this week.

Say:

- Who remembers what our Super Clue is today? (*a microphone*)
- What does a microphone help us remember? (*A microphone helps us remember that we can tell people about Jesus.*)
- What was your favorite part of Large Group?
- **I can tell about Jesus.** Who are some people you would like to tell about Jesus? (*Answers will vary.*) What can you tell them about Jesus? (*Jesus is God's Son. Jesus is very special. Jesus loves you.*)
- What did you learn about God today?
- What part of the Bible story do you remember?

Our Big Deal is, Lead the Way, God helps me Obey!

Lead the Way! (*Swipe both hands down from head to hips with hands facing each other.*)

God Helps Me Obey! (*Put two thumbs up.*)

It's really cool that God helps us obey Him. One thing we can do to obey God is to tell people about Jesus. We can tell our friends, family, and people everywhere about Jesus.

Going Home

Prepare kids to talk with their family about what they learned today.

- Pass out coloring pages for kids to take home.
- As family members arrive to pick up their kid, greet them and tell them one thing you noticed about their kid that day or something you talked to each kid about remembering this week.
- If there is time to chat with the family, ask how you can pray for them this week.
- Say bye to the kids and call them by name.
