### I Am Set Apart

#### 1 year olds - 4 year olds

#### Leader Notes

**Bible Passage:** Saul learned about Jesus- Acts 9

**Bottom Line:** I can stand up.

**Leader Context:** Paul was transformed when he encountered Jesus on the road to Damascus, and his transformation led to a boldness to share the gospel. We get to teach kids that following Jesus means standing up for Him, by boldly and passionately sharing Him with those around us.

**THE WIN FOR SUNDAY GROUPS:** Give kids a first look at The Bible, Jesus, and our need for a Savior by embracing their physical needs or engaging their interests. Use The Code when necessary to help redirect kids and build relationships.

#### Games and Music (10 minutes)

**What You Need:** April 28 Social Instruction Page, Game Sets, Roku Game Instructions, hula hoops (4 per group) Assorted colored paper (at least 4 colors)

**What You Do:**

- Play worship songs and other songs available on Roku during the Social Game or while kids are playing.
- Using the supplies and game instruction page, choose one game to play with the kids today.
- As you are playing, use this as a time to call each kid by name and learn their names well.

**Say:** That was a fun game to get us ready to watch our Bible video. Let's sit and listen to our story today."

#### Bible Story Video (10 minutes)

##### Bible Story Recap- Say This!

Thanks, Super Crew! You really helped us out!

What a great Bible story we got to hear today. In this Bible story we learned about how Saul made some wrong choices. Saul did not like people who loved Jesus. Saul wanted to hurt people who loved Jesus and even wanted to put them in jail. Even when Saul did not obey God or follow His plan, God still loved him. Saul listened to God's voice, and he was changed. He went from wrong choices that disobeyed God to listening to God and making right choices. And he even ended up telling many, many people about Jesus! Just like Saul listened to God, we can listen to God too. God helps us listen and know what we should do.

When we listen to God and follow His plan, we obey Him.

Let's pray and thank God for helping listen to and us obey Him. Remember that prayer is talking and listening to God. Let's close our eyes and pray in 3-2-1.

"God, thank You for helping us listen and obey. I pray we remember that You have great plans for us. Amen.."

**Big Deal:** Night and Day(Stack arms on top of each other, then swing top arm up to make a right angle)God (Point up) Helps me Obey!(give two thumbs up)

Let's do that a few more times.

#### Videos

**Listening Ears (20 minutes)**

**What You Need:** "Listening ears printable (1 set per kid- cut out), crayons, stapler, gluesticks, scissors (for leaders)

**Say:** Today we are learning that God helps us listen. What do we use to listen? (*allow responses*) That's right! We listen with our ears. We are going to make a really fun listening hat with ears to remind us that God helps us listen. After you color your two rectangles and your two ears, we will help you put your listening hats together. To do that we will take the two rectangles and help you measure them on your head. Then we will staple the strips together to fit your head, After that we will help you glue your ears to your listening hat.

**Say :** "You all look so great in your listening ears! I love how we all made the same thing, but each of you made yours look special and unique. Great job! God got Saul's attention in a big way! Saul listened to Jesus' voice and obeyed what He said. Listening and following God is important. Do you remember our Super Clue? (*allow responses*) Yes! A bell! Just like a bell can get our attention, we should pay attention to what God says so we can obey Him. When we wear our listening ears, we can remember that God helps us listen."

**Say:**

- What was our Super Clue today? (*a bell*) What does a bell help us remember? (*A bell gets our attention, it can remind us to listen to God.*)
- What was your favorite part of the Bible story?
- We learned that God helps me listen. How does God help you listen? (*God gets our attention and reminds us to listen.*)
- What is something you learned about God today?
- What can you tell your friends and families about this week?

Our Big Deal is, "Night and Day! God help me obey !"

Night and Day(*Stack arms on top of each other, then swing top arm up to make a right angle*)

God (*Point up*)

Helps me Obey!(*give two thumbs up*)

God loves us and gives us what we need so that we can do big things for Him. We can listen to God and obey Him. Just like Saul, we'll be changed forever when we listen and follow Him."

**Prepare kids to talk with their family about what they learned today.**

- Pass out coloring pages for kids to take home.
- As family members arrive to pick up their kid, greet them and tell them one thing you noticed about their kid that day or something you talked to each kid about remembering this week.
- If there is time to chat with the family, ask how you can pray for them this week.
- Say bye to the kids and call them by name.
