SOCIAL TIME

The first 10-15 minutes as kid's arrive are some of our most important times to meet needs and show kids they are valued. This is why we provide strategic activities for you help engage with every kid as they arrive.

- This month you have Animal Action Cards and Tiny Dot Number Cards.
- You will also find 2 Social activities each week. ***Use one now and one at the end to redirect attention.*

Games and Music (10 minutes)

What You Need: Social Game Instruction Page including Roku Games, Bark Color Pages (1 per kid) crayons, Masking tape, Cardstock Hearts (1 per kid), markers, painter's tape (1 per group), music and music player (1 per group optional), Ball pit ball (1 per group), Lunch box (1 per group)

What You Do:

- Play worship songs and other songs available on Roku during the Social Game or while kids are playing.
- Using the supplies and game instruction page, choose one game to play with the kids today.
- As you are playing, use this as a time to call each kid by name and learn their names well.

Say: That was a fun game to get us ready to watch our Bible video. Let's sit and listen to our story today."

Bible Story Video (10 minutes)**Bible Story - Say This!**

Thank you, Super Crew, for helping us out! In our Bible story today, David understood that God knew everything about him. God even knew the words David would speak. God knows everything about us too! God leads us to know Him because He loves us. Our Super Clue, a lunch box, tells us a lot about what we like and don't like. The person who packs our lunch knows what we like and what is healthy for us to eat. God knows even more about us, and He leads us to know Him. This means God gives us His Word, the Bible, and people who know and follow Him to help us learn more about Him and know Him better!

Let's take a moment to pray as we talk and listen to God.

Thank You, God, for knowing us and leading us to know You. Thank You for loving each of us and having a special plan for our lives. Amen.

Can you say the Big Deal with me?

Follow the Leader! (*Push right fist up.*)

God Has a Plan for Me! (*Cross arms in front of body, making a small circle with palms up.*)

Balloon Pass Activity (20 minutes)

Big Goal: Review the Main Idea: **God leads me to know Him.**

Supplies: "Allergy Alert" printable (1 per group), Balloons (several), Music and music player (1 per group)

What To Do: It's Hooray Day, so I think we should play a game using a balloon! Let's make a circle to play this game. Our game is called "Balloon Pass." What is it called? (*Balloon Pass!*) We are going to pass this balloon around the circle as fast as we can. When the music stops, we will stop passing the balloon and say, **"God leads me to know Him,"** together. Once we say that, the music and balloon passing will start again. Before we begin, let's say, **"God leads me to know Him."** I will say it first, and you can say it after me. **God leads me to know Him! (God leads me to know Him!)** Great job! I think we are ready to play.

Keep It Going: For additional rounds, consider reversing the direction the balloon travels or encourage the individual holding the balloon to say the Main Idea with you by themselves.

Leader Tip: For larger groups, consider forming several smaller groups of 8-10 preschoolers for the game. Consider playing the monthly Theme song.

Safety Tip: Quickly pick up and discard pieces if a balloon pops. These can be choking hazards.

Loud And Clear: This game was so much fun! We have so much to celebrate. I am so glad God leads us to know Him. We can be excited about knowing God. God loves each of you and has a special plan for your lives. Let's say, **"God leads me to know Him,"** one more time. Ready? **"God leads me to know Him!"** Awesome!

TALK IT OUT

Say:

- Who remembers what our Super Clue is today? *(a lunch box)*
- What does a lunch box help us remember? *(When you open your lunch box, you can see all the yummy foods you like to eat inside. The person who packed your lunch knows you very well. They know what food is good for you and what you need to grow. God knows us, and He leads us to know Him. God knows everything about us. He has a special plan for us and loves us so much.)*
- What is something King David learned about God? *(God knew everything about him and still loved him.)*
- **God leads me to know Him.** How can we know God and have a friendship with Him? *(God sent Jesus to make a way for us to be forgiven and have a friendship with Him. We can know God when we have a friendship with Him. We can have a friendship with God when we ask Him to forgive us for our wrong choices.)*
- What did you learn about God today?
- How can you learn more about God? *(Listen to stories from the Bible, go to church, sing songs about God, learn Bible verses, and so on.)*

Keep It Going: Instruct preschoolers to line up and say the Big Deal together while marching around the room.

Big Deal:

Follow the Leader! *(Push right fist up.)*

God Has a Plan for Me! *(Cross arms in front of body, making a small circle with palms up.)*

Today we learned that God leads us to know Him. King David wrote about how God knew everything about him and loved him. God knows us, and God wants us to know Him too.

GOING HOME

Prepare kids to talk with their family about what they learned today.

- Pass out coloring pages for kids to take home.
- As family members arrive to pick up their kid, greet them and tell them one thing you noticed about their kid that day or something you talked to each kid about remembering this week.
- If there is time to chat with the family, ask how you can pray for them this week.
- Say bye to the kids and call them by name.
