Teachers Dig In

Dig In to the Bible

- Read: Luke 2:1-7
- In This Passage: Despite being the king of the universe, Jesus comes to earth in the most humble form: a baby. He's not born in a palace or fancy home; he's born in a stable to lower-class parents. Jesus is humble, and he shows it in his humble birth.
- Bible Point: Jesus is humble...
- Application: ...so we show humility.
- Summary Verse: "He took the humble position of a slave and was born as a human being" (Philippians 2:7).

Dig Deeper

- You'll Be Teaching: *Jesus is humble.* Humility seems to be a lost art form these days. Our culture teaches kids to have a "me, me, me" attitude. And most kids naturally focus more on getting than giving. Help kids see that Jesus came in a humble way even though he *deserved* the very best.
- Think About: Who's the most humble person you know? What characteristics about that person do you most admire?

Dig In to Prayer

- Pray that God would give kids his humble heart.

Quick Tip

- Kids are used to adults talking *at* them, not *with* them. Sometimes when adults do ask questions, they have a specific answer in mind that they're seeking. This isn't a discussion; it's a hunt for correct responses. Demonstrate humility by recognizing that your kids may be able to teach *you*. Ask the provided questions that facilitate honest, genuine discussion. Let God humble you as you see him through kids' eyes.
