### I Am Meant to Know God 1 year olds - 4 year olds

#### Leader Notes

**Bible Passage:** Philip and the Ethiopian Official- Acts 8:26-40

**Bottom Line:** God Shows us Himself through His book.

**Leader Context:** Just like the Ethiopian official in Acts 8, we can know God more by reading His word, the Bible. We can help kids know they don't have to be older or wiser to read God's Word, they can start today. We can be intentional about reading the Bible too. The Bible is for each of us, not just pasors or people who go to Bible school. We don't need to be intimidated because God wrote the Bible to be understood by all of us.

**THE WIN FOR SUNDAY GROUPS:** Give kids a first look at The Bible, Jesus, and our need for a Savior by embracing their physical needs or engaging their interests. Use The Code when necessary to help redirect kids and build relationships.

#### Games and Music (10 minutes)

**What You Need:** Feb 11 Social Instruction Page, Game Sets, Roku Game Instructions, I spy printable (1 per kid) magnifying glasses, construction paper hearts or felt hearts (1 per kid)

#### What You Do:

- Play worship songs and other songs available on Roku during the Social Game or while kids are playing.
- Using the supplies and game instruction page, choose one game to play with the kids today.
- As you are playing, use this as a time to call each kid by name and learn their names well.

**Say:** That was a fun game to get us ready to watch our Bible video. Let's sit and listen to our story today."

#### Bible Story Video (10 minutes)

#### Bible Story Recap- Say This!

Thank you so much, Super Crew! You all are awesome! Do you remember what the Super Clue is today? (Allow responses.) A Bible! Very good! Did you hear how the Super Crew connected the Bible to the Bible story and the Big Deal? They helped us know that God shows us Himself through His Book, the Bible! The Bible is God's Word, and we can learn more about God as we read it. Even if you can't read yet, you can ask your family or friends to read to you. Let's pray, thanking God for His Word. Praying is talking and listening to God. Let's be still, close our eyes, and pray 3-2-1.

God, thank You for the Bible. Help us learn more about You when we spend time reading and listening to the Bible. Amen."

Can you say the Big Deal with me?

I Spy! (*point to eyes*)

God wants me! (*Move hands to chest*)

To Know Him! (*point to sky*)

Let's do that a few more times.

#### Videos

**The B-I-B-L-E (20 minutes)**

**What You Need:** Bible printable (1 per kid, cuout), construction paper (1 per kid) glue sticks, crayons

**Say:**

Today we are learning about God's Word, the Bible. Let's make a craft where we spell out the word Bible. *(Hold up a sample craft.)* As I point to each letter and say its name repeat the letter after me. Ready? B(B), I(I), B(B), L(L), E(E) Great job! The first step in making our craft if to get one of each letter. *(Pass out the letters)* I will show you a letter, and I want you to try to find it. Then we will glue the letter on our paper. *(Assist preschoolers with finding correct letters and gluing them in order.)* Wow! You spelled Bible! If you would like, you can color the letters with some of your favorite colors.

**Say:** "The Bible is a special book. It is God's Book. We can know God through His Book, the Bible. When we learn about what is in the Bible, we learn morea about God and Jesus, just like the man in today's Bible story. The Bible is true, and it's for you!"

**Say:**

- What was our Super Clue today? *(a Bible)* What does it help us remember?*(We can know God through His Book- the Bible)*
- What was your favorite part of the Bible story?
- We can know God through His Book. What is the name of God's Book? *(The Bible)*
- What is something you learned about God today?
- What can you tell your friends and families about this week?

Our Big Deal is, "I Spy! God wants me to Know Him"

I Spy*(Point to eyes.)*

God wants me *(Move hands to chest)*

to Know Him*( Point to sky)*

As we hear stories from the Bible, we can learn more about God. The Bible is God's Word. Everything in the Bible really happened. The Bible is true, and it's for you!"

**Prepare kids to talk with their family about what they learned today.**

- Pass out coloring pages for kids to take home.
- As family members arrive to pick up their kid, greet them and tell them one thing you noticed about their kid that day or something you talked to each kid about remembering this week.
- If there is time to chat with the family, ask how you can pray for them this week.
- Say bye to the kids and call them by name.
