**I Am Meant to Know God**  
**1 year olds - 4 year olds**

**Leader Notes**

**Bible Passage:** Jesus and Nicodemus- John 3

**Bottom Line:** God shows Us Himself through His Son.

**Leader Context:** We are meant to know God. God sent His son, Jesus, to help us know God more. We see in John 3, that Nicodemus learned about God through a conversation he had with Jesus. This is a great day to invite kids to ask questions about why we need Jesus and what it means to follow Him.

**THE WIN FOR SUNDAY GROUPS:** Give kids a first look at The Bible, Jesus, and our need for a Savior by embracing their physical needs or engaging their interests. Use The Code when necessary to help redirect kids and build relationships.

**Games and Music (10 minutes)**

**What You Need:** Feb 18 Social Instruction Page, Game Sets, Roku Game Instructions, I spy printable (1 per kid) magnifying glasses, Four corners printable (1 set per group) painter's tape

**What You Do:**

- Play worship songs and other songs available on Roku during the Social Game or while kids are playing.
- Using the supplies and game instruction page, choose one game to play with the kids today.
- As you are playing, use this as a time to call each kid by name and learn their names well.

**Say:** That was a fun game to get us ready to watch our Bible video. Let's sit and listen to our story today."

**Bible Story Video (10 minutes)**

**Bible Story Recap- Say This!**

Thank you so much, Super Crew! I loved seeing the picture of Bark! When we looked at the picture of Bark, we could see what color he is, how many spots he has, and even see his floppy ears. When we read our Bible and learn about Jesus, we can learn more about God. We can see how He loves each of us and how we can follow Him. God shows us Himself through His Son, Who is God's Son? (Allow responses) Jesus! Very good. God sent His only Son, Jesus, for us. Jesus taught people what God is like. Let's pray and thank God for His Son, Jesus. Praying is talking and listening to God. Let's be still, close our eyes, and pray 3-2-1.

God, thank You for Jesus.. Help us learn more about You as we learn more about Jesus. Amen."

Can you say the Big Deal with me?

I Spy! (*point to eyes*)

God wants me! (*Move hands to chest*)

To Know Him! (*point to sky*)

Let's do that a few more times.

**DIY Picture Frame (20 minutes)**

**What You Need:** Paper Picture frame (1 per kid), sticky back pom poms, paint dotters, dot stickers, (Little ones may need just paint dot and circle stickers, older kids can stick on pom poms)

**Say:**

Does anyone remember what our Super Clue is today? (Allow responses) Yes! It is a picture! Do you have pictures at your house? I have pictures at my house. Some of my pictures are in picture frames, like this. Picture frames hold pictures to make them easy to display and see. Let's make our own picture frames. We can decorate our frames with crayons and then add pom-poms to make them even more colorful. Invite kids to add fun details to the frames with crayons.

**Say :** "The Bible says that looking at Jesus is like looking at an exact picture of God. God want us to know Him. One way we can know Him more is through Jesus. When we learn more about what Jesus is like, we learn more about what God is like.

**Say:**

- What was our Super Clue today? *(a frame/picture)* What does it help us remember?*(That Jesus is like a picture of what God is like. Pictures help show us something that is real. Jesus came to show us more about God. When we look at Jesus, we see God!)*
- What was your favorite part of the Bible story?
- We can know God through His Son. What is the name of God's Son? *(Jesus)*
- What is something you learned about God today?
- What can you tell your friends and families about this week?

Our Big Deal is, "I Spy! God wants me to Know Him"

I Spy*(Point to eyes.)*

God wants me *(Move hands to chest)*

God wants us to know Him. We can know God through His Son, Jesus!"

**Prepare kids to talk with their family about what they learned today.**

- Pass out coloring pages for kids to take home.
- As family members arrive to pick up their kid, greet them and tell them one thing you noticed about their kid that day or something you talked to each kid about remembering this week.
- If there is time to chat with the family, ask how you can pray for them this week.
- Say bye to the kids and call them by name.
